

Why Do You Use the Names “Yahveh” and “Yahshua” In This Book, Instead of Jehovah and Jesus?

Who has ascended up into heaven, or descended? Who has gathered the wind in his fists? Who has bound the waters in a garment? Who has established all the ends of the earth? What is his name, and what is his son's name, if thou can tell? — Proverbs 30:4

In this book, you will come across the name “Yahveh” and “Yahshua” and since many people have no knowledge of these names, I will like to explain the meaning of these names.

Satan and all demons fear only two powerful names. Surprisingly, such two powerful names are not Jehovah and Jesus Christ as you may presume. The Bible says, ***“Who has ascended up into heaven, or descended? Who has gathered the wind in his fists? Who has bound the waters in a garment? Who has established all the ends of the earth? What is his name, and what is his son's name, if thou can tell? (Proverbs 30:4).*** The creator of heaven and earth has revealed His true name and the true name of his Son to me and I have delivered a lot of people from spiritual marriage or demonic forces through these two powerful names. You will witness the power in

these two powerful names whenever you visit me at my deliverance prayer session. If you pronounce these great names consistently in your prayers and command the demonic spirits to leave you in the name of these powerful names, the demons will yield to the power of these two great names and flee away. There have been so many testimonies in my assembly from victims who have become free from these spirits which have held them down for so many years through the use of the true sacred name of God and that of his son, the Messiah.

Note: The name that the Archangel Gabriel brought to Mary to be given to the Son of God was not Jesus. The Bible says, ***“Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved” (Acts 4:12)***, apart from the name Yahshua. If you want to get total deliverance and freedom from these demonic spirits, then learn to use the power of these two names to command the demons to leave you and they will.

The True and Powerful Name of the Creator

The True Sacred Name of the creator is not Jehovah. God and Lord are titles that the Creator bears; they are not the real powerful name of the Creator that demons tremble at. The true sacred and powerful name of the Creator of heaven and earth is ***“Yahveh”*** (YHVH — Yod Hey Vav Hey). Read Genesis 22:14, Exodus 6:2, 3; 17:1 and Psalm 83:18. Note that “Yahweh” is a close pronunciation to the true name “Yahveh” but it is inaccurate. This is because there is no ‘w’ sound in the Hebrew language. Ava Yahveh is the true name of the Creator. Yahveh is a Hebrew word and the Hebrew language is also a heavenly language. Ava means “Father” and Yahveh means “I will be who I will be”.

According to the Book of Jewish Knowledge Encyclopedia, by Nathan Ausubel, *“There is more than a tinge of irony for Jews in the thought that the first Biblical scholar to make the discovery that the Pentateuch was the composite product of at least two different documents was a French Roman Catholic, Jean Astruc (1684 – 1766), who thereby became the founder of modern Biblical criticism. He had arrived at his hypothesis in an interesting way. Nonplused by the obviously unnecessary repetitions and confusing chronology in the narrative portions of the Book of Genesis, he was even more puzzled to designate God. One was the ineffable Name, YHVH, which is pronounced “Yahveh” (in 1518 it was written for the first time as “Jehovah” by Peter Gallatin, the confessor of Pope Leo X). The other was the odd plural rendering Elohim (singular: El) — for God. From the appearance in the text of these two different names, Astruc deduced that there had been effected a fusion of two separate Scriptural documents in Genesis, most probably by Ezra the Scribe. Wherever the name Elohim appeared, Astruc ascribed the passage in which it was set to the documents that he named “Elohists,” and the passages in which YHVH occurred he attributed to the “Yahvist” version”*

The True and Powerful Name of the Son of Yahveh

In the same way, Jesus Christ is not the true name of the son of Yahveh likewise the names “Yesu”, “Isous” and “Yeshua”. Yahshua Ha Mashiach [translation: Yahshua the Messiah] is the only true sacred and powerful name of the son of Yahveh which demons fear and tremble at. Yahshua is a Hebrew name that was given to the Messiah by Yahveh himself through the Archangel Gabriel. Yahshua means “*Yahveh saves or Yahveh is our savior*” and Mashiach (*Translation: Messiah*) means “*The Anointed One*”.

CHAPTER 1

What Are Demons and Evil Spirits?

Demons are evil supernatural beings or fallen angels who joined Satan in his rebellion against Yahveh and who were defeated and cast out of heaven.

There are three main theories about the discussion of who demons are and where they come from. The theories are:

1. Demons are disembodied spirits of a pre-adamic race.
2. Demons are spirits of the evil dead.
3. Demons are the offspring (Nephilim) of the cohabitation of fallen angels with earthly women.

I have discussed these three theories in detail and break down which is the most plausible based on Scripture or simply the truth in my book titled: *“Spiritual Battles Volume 2 – The Origin of Demons and the Harm They Could Cause”*

The word *“evil spirits”* is another term for demons because demons are also spirits associated with evil.

Another definition by the Encyclopedia Britannica says, *“Demons are malevolent spiritual beings that mediate between the transcendent and temporal realms.”*

The Ancient Greek word δαίμων (*daimōn*) denotes a spirit or divine power. A demon is considered a harmful spiritual entity that may cause demonic possession, calling for an exorcism. The term “demon” from the Greek New Testament δαιμόνιον (*daimonion*) appears 63 times in the New Testament of the Bible.

Encyclopedia.com gave a description of the general view of demonic spirits: *“Demons have an expansive role in the biblical record. They can affect the behavior of swine (Matthew 8:30-32) and speak with knowledge beyond that of an ordinary person (Mark 1:23-24). Biblical authors did understand demons as objectively present in the world and pictured the apostles as trying to drive them away...By the third century, the angel Lucifer, who fell from heaven (Isaiah 14:12), was identified with Satan, and the fallen angels with demons.”*

Moreover, demons are corrupted spirits carrying the execution of Satan’s desires. Demons are of two classes, the Nephilim and the fallen angels (that sided with Lucifer and were cast out of heaven by Michael during the war in heaven). These classes of demons are fully treated in

chapter 4 of my book titled: *“Spiritual Battles Volume 2 – The Origin of Demons and the Harm They Could Cause”*

The Origin of Demons



“All things were made through Him, and without Him, nothing was made that was made” (John 1:3).

“For by Him, all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him” (Colossians 1:16).



Here, I will discuss in detail the truth about the origin of demons. All other theories or teachings which do not agree with what I am about to share with you are fallacies and should be ignored.

Cohabitation of Angels With Earthly Women

The first class of demons originated from the cohabitation between angels and earthly women who lived before the flood. And that the demons did not exist before this point. This study takes Genesis 6:1-4 as referring to the unlawful marriages between fallen angels and human women. Their offspring were Nephilim whom many believe to be half-humans, half-angelic: ***“And it came to pass when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born unto them. That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose. And the LORD said, my spirit shall not always strive with man, for that he also is flesh: yet his days shall be a hundred and twenty years. There were giants in the earth in those days; and also after that, when the sons of God came in unto the daughters of men, and they bare children to them, the same became mighty men which were of old, men of renown” (Genesis 6:1-4).***

This class of demons roams about the earth harassing weak human beings sexually through their dreams and also has spiritual children with them. These demons cannot have physical children with human beings, because they are disembodied spirits who have lost their human bodies through the flood. Another reason is, they are limited in power to the fallen angels — possess

little power as compared to the one-third of the host of heavens (angels) that were cast out of heaven.

Some may argue against this truth by saying that the sons of God, the book of Genesis mentioned were not referred to as the angels in heaven. Their reason may be that angels cannot have sexual intercourse with human beings. They may quote this scripture in support of their views: ***“For in the resurrection they neither marry, nor are given in marriage, but are as the angels of God in heaven” (Matthew 22:30)***. But the truth concerning the context of this scripture is that Yahshua the Messiah did not say, angels cannot have sexual intercourse with human beings, he only meant that sexual intercourse is not allowed in heaven, as do stealing and killing or any other type of sin. Lucifer and his angels sinned in heaven and because Yahveh doesn't want that to continue in heaven, he cast Lucifer and his angels out of heaven. It does not mean that sin or sexual intercourse is not possible among the angels of God. If it is not possible then how come pride which is also a sin came within Lucifer a high-ranking angel of Yahveh? This is what Yahveh says of Lucifer, ***“Thou art the anointed cherub that covereth; and I have set thee so: thou wast upon the holy mountain of God; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire. Thou wast perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, till iniquity was found in thee” (Ezekiel 28:14, 15)***.

Before anyone will argue on this point, the person should bear in mind that only the angels in heaven don't marry or are not allowed to marry. Here, we are talking about angels that have fallen from the truth — rebellious sons of God who have sided with Lucifer a long time ago before the generation of Noah. Rebellious angels have no respect for any law or order. So sexual intercourse or fornication would not be out of the question for fallen angels.

From the above study, it is clear that Yahshua's teaching concerning no marriage in heaven among the saints or the angels doesn't have any bearing with the incident in Genesis 6:1-4.

Others also misinterpret Genesis 6:1-4 by saying that the “sons of God” refer to the righteous lineage from Seth, while the “daughters of men” represent the wicked descendants of Cain. Therefore, the giants [offspring of the sons of God] were not demons. But that's a big fallacy and you shouldn't pay attention to this myth.

This theory surmises that Seth's line had intermarried a pagan line. However, why would this union produce giants and heroes? If believers married unbelievers, will this produce giants and heroes? Absolutely, no!

The name “Nephilim” means giants. The union of the sons of God and the daughters of men produced a race of giants — the offspring of fallen angels and humans.

The truth is revealed in the Book of Enoch. But the question some may ask is “is this book legitimate or scripture? My answer is yes, this should have been part of the Holy Scriptures translated and given to us but our translators omitted that book. One thing we should know is that the truth can never be hidden forever. It will surely sprout. The Bible says, ***“For there is nothing covered, that shall not be revealed; and hid, that shall not be known” (Matthew 10:26)***. Though our translators omitted this book, the Holy Spirit included it in the Holy Scriptures through the disciple Jude.

During my research and study, I came across the Book of Enoch in Jude 14 and 15. This book was quoted by Jude a true disciple of Yahshua. Jude quoted 1 Enoch 1:9 in his book, which says, ***“And Enoch also, the seventh from Adam, prophesied of these, saying, Behold, the Lord cometh with ten thousands of his saints, to execute judgment upon all, and to convince all that are ungodly among them of all their ungodly deeds which they have ungodly committed, and of all their hard speeches which ungodly sinners have spoken against him”***

The Bible never mentions one word that Enoch spoke, so how did the disciple Jude know what Enoch prophesied? The only reference to Enoch in the Old Testament is in Genesis 5:18-24. When you read it, you won't find any reference to this prophecy that Jude mentioned. The Bible just mentions the fact that Enoch walked with Yahveh and was no more because Yahveh took him away. Nothing is mentioned about his prophesying.

So how did Jude get to know that Enoch had prophesied these words? He knew it because the book of Enoch mentions it. The book was well-known and was highly regarded by the Jews in Yahshua's day and by the apostles and they freely quoted from it, therefore, giving the book credibility.

Now that we are clear, let's explore more on the topic.

In the Book of Enoch, the “sons of God” mentioned in Genesis 6:2 were fallen angels. It added that these fallen angels produced a race of beings that were half humans and half angelic called the Nephilim. And when they were destroyed by the flood, they remained on the earth as demons. Let me share with you a portion of the book of Enoch:

“It happened after the sons of men had multiplied in those days, that daughters were born to them, elegant and beautiful. And when the angels, the sons of heaven, beheld them, they became enamoured of them, saying to each other, Come, let us select for ourselves wives from the progeny of men, and let us beget children” (1 Enoch 7:2).

“Now the giants, who have been born of spirit and of flesh, shall be called upon earth evil spirits, and on earth shall be their habitation. Evil spirits shall proceed from their flesh because they were created from above; from the holy Watchers was their beginning and primary foundation. Evil spirits shall they be upon earth, and the spirits of the wicked shall they be called. The habitation of the spirits of heaven shall be in heaven; but upon earth shall be the habitation of terrestrial spirits, who are born on earth. The spirits of the giants shall be like clouds, which shall oppress, corrupt, fall, contend, and bruise upon earth. They shall cause lamentation. No food shall they eat; and they shall be thirsty; they shall be concealed, and shall not rise up against the sons of men, and against women; for they come forth during the days of slaughter and destruction” (1 Enoch 15:8-10).

It is clear from the Book of Enoch that evil spirits are the giants who were born from the union of spirits and flesh. Note that another name for an evil spirit is a demon.

It seems clear that the book of Genesis is a compilation of the writings of the patriarchs. This will explain why Genesis contains so many different writing styles; this has unfortunately given way to an unfair attack on the authorship of Moses. However, Moses simply used the writings of the patriarchs to put together his book. He often keeps the exact words that the patriarchs used.

This means that if we are to understand the term “sons of God” it would be best to compare this term with a similar term from a book that was written during the same period, in this case, during the times of the patriarchs. Fortunately, we have such a book. It’s the book of Job. The book of Job was written during the patriarchal period. The term “sons of God” is mentioned in Job 1:6: ***“Now there was a day when the sons of God came to present themselves before the LORD, and Satan came also among them.”***

Here we find that the “sons of God” were angels, and Satan is numbered among them.

The sons of God were also mentioned in Job 38:7: ***“When the morning stars sang together, and all the sons of God shouted for joy?”***

This scripture is written in a literary technique called Hebrew Parallelism, which means that the identical thing is said in two different ways. This means morning stars are the same as sons of God. Satan once was called the morning star (Lucifer), which identifies him with the angels. He was among the morning stars that sang for joy when God created the universe. All the angels are also called the sons of God.

It seems clear then that the term “sons of God” as used in Genesis would mean angels since Job uses this term in that way.

So Genesis 6:1-4 is saying that angels came and had sexual intercourse with human beings (women) and their offspring known as the Nephilim became demons because they are the descendants of a group of fallen angels who were also known as demons. Note this, any fallen angel is a demon. Therefore, Satan is also a demon.

This is by far the truth about what demons are. There are many false teachings and myths about the origin of demons. If you want to find out what those false teachings and myths are, order a copy of my book titled *“The Origin of Demons and the Harm They Could Cause”*

CHAPTER 2

Why Do Demons Need A Human Body



Is it possible for demons to materialize? Can they appear in either human or animal form? Is it possible for them to create some physical form and simply appear?



Human Forms

You may look through the pages of the whole Bible and you will find no clear example of a demon materializing. Even though some demons are disembodied spirits, there is no evidence that demons have the power to create some human form in which to appear. This is beyond their capabilities.

However, demons are powerless to work evil against human beings unless they dwell in a body. They need bodies to work evil. The Bible says, ***“When an unclean spirit goes out of a man, he goes through dry places, seeking rest, and finds none. Then he says, ‘I will return to my house from which I came.’ And when he comes, he finds it empty, swept, and put in order. Then he goes and takes with him seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter and dwell there; and the last state of that man is worse than the first...”*** (Matthew 12:43-45).

If demons could simply materialize and cause chaos with humankind, then they wouldn’t be constantly looking for some human body to live in. This is a further indication that demons cannot appear at will in some human-like or animal-like form.

When the demons were cast out of the man at Gadera by Yahshua the Messiah, they didn’t want to be bodiless, they rather want to enter into the bodies of pigs. The Bible says, ***“Now a large herd of swine was feeding there near the mountains. So all the demons begged Him, saying, “Send us to the swine, that we may enter them.” And at once Jesus [Yashua] gave them permission. Then the unclean spirits went out and entered the swine (there were about two thousand); and the herd ran violently down the steep place into the sea, and drowned in the sea”*** (Mark 5:11-12).

Other Physical Forms

While there is no Scriptural evidence that demons can simply materialize, they can assume other physical forms than human forms. The Bible says, ***“Then the fifth angel sounded: And I saw a star fallen from heaven to the earth. To him was given the key to the bottomless pit. And he opened the bottomless pit, and smoke arose out of the pit like the smoke of a great furnace. So the sun and the air were darkened because of the smoke of the pit. Then out of the smoke locusts came upon the earth. And to them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power”*** (Revelation 9:1-3).

Another evidence of demons materializing in animal-like form appeared in Revelation 16: 13, 14: ***“And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs coming out of the mouth of the dragon, out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet. For they are spirits of demons, performing signs, which go out to the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.”***

The idea that demons can somehow materialize in human form is not found in the Holy Scripture and there is not enough information to make that conclusion. However, the Bible speaks of the disembodied demons going around trying to find human beings in which to possess. Demons do appear in animal-like forms in the Book of Revelation and but not in human forms.

CHAPTER 3

How Demons Enter Your Body and Home

Demonic Possession

Demonic possession is the hypothetical control of a human body by a spirit, demon, or other entity. Demonic possession may be considered voluntary or involuntary and it has harmful effects on the host. The effects or symptoms of being demonic possessed may include perceptual distortions, loss of a sense of control, missing memories, and hyper-suggestibility.

There are two ways to become possessed by demons; either the demon passes directly into a person, or someone, usually said to be a witch or wizard, working with Satan sends a demon into the person through bewitchment.

A true believer of Yahshua the Messiah and at the same time a keeper of the Ten Commandments of Ava Yahveh is hedged with Yahveh's protection so that demons can't enter into him or her. An opening in this protective hedge should be made before demons can enter the person to dwell in his or her body. If there's one major thing that breaks this hedge, it is SIN. Sin breaks a hole in a person's protective hedge which allows demons to enter into the person sinning. These holes are called *doorways or entry points or gateways*. The Bible says, ***"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness"*** (1 John 1:9).

A person whose inward parts are empty and not filled with the spirit of Yahveh opens another doorway for more demonic infestations. The Bible says, ***"When an unclean spirit goes out of a man, he goes through dry places, seeking rest, and finds none. Then he says, 'I will return to my house from which I came.' And when he comes, he finds it empty, swept, and put in order. Then he goes and takes with him seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter and dwell there; and the last state of that man is worse than the first..."*** (Matthew 12:43-45).

Any dealing with satanic agents opens a doorway for demons to enter into you. The Bible says, ***"Give no regard to mediums and familiar spirits; do not seek after them, to be defiled by them: I am the LORD your God"*** (Lev. 19:31).

So as a believer and law keeper, you should be aware of these entry points. The Bible says, ***"My people are destroyed for lack of knowledge. Because you have rejected knowledge, I also will reject you from being priest for Me; Because you have forgotten the law of your God, I also will forget your children"*** (Hosea 4:6).

Only when you become aware of Satan's subtle schemes that, you will be able to guard yourself against his tricks. What are these doorways? The Bible discreetly and significantly enumerates demonic footholds and entry points.

There are many ways demons can possess you or enter your body and home. We shall discuss some of the main ways here:

Entry Point #1: False Religion

Being involved in a false religion may open your body doorways and home for demons to enter.

There is only one way to the Kingdom of Yahveh and that is through the obedience of the Law and the faith of Yahshua the Messiah, the son of Yahveh. Yahshua declared, ***"I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me"*** (John 14:6). Yahshua instructed us, ***"Enter by the narrow gate; for wide is the gate and broad is the way that leads to destruction, and there are many who go in by it. Because narrow is the gate and difficult is the way which leads to life, and there are few who find it"*** (Matthew 7:13, 14).

The truth of the matter is that *there is only one religion*; I mean only one way that *leads* believers to Yahveh's Kingdom. It is a way *designed and established* by the Creator himself not men. This true religion has *two* major fundamental steps that lead all believers to our Father in heaven. The two steps are:

(I) The obedience of the Ten Commandment (including the observance of the 7th Day Sabbath — Saturday worship) and other unaltered or unchanged laws in the statutes, precepts, judgments, and commandments of Yahveh and the celebration of Yahveh's festivals: New Moon Festival, Passover Feast, Feast of Unleavened Bread, Feast of Weeks (Pentecost), Feast of Trumpet, Day of Atonement and the Feast of Tabernacle.

Read Exodus 20:1-17, Deuteronomy 10:1-5, Deuteronomy 31:24-26, Leviticus 10:11, Deuteronomy 6:17, Psalms 119:4, Psalms 119:155, Deuteronomy 16:16, Leviticus 23:1-37, 1 Chronicles 23:31 and Isaiah 66:22, 23 for further understanding.

(II) The Faith and Testimony of Yahshua the Messiah.

The Holy Scripture verifies this:

“And the dragon was enraged with the woman, and he went to make war with the rest of her offspring, who keep the commandments of God and have the testimony of Jesus Christ [Yahshua the Messiah]” (Revelation 12:17).

“Here is the patience of the saints; here are those who keep the commandments of God [Yahveh] and the faith of Jesus [Yahshua]” (Revelation 14:12).

This religion I am talking about is none other than *Messianic Judaism*. All other religions out there are false religions set by Satan and his demons.

When you become a member of any of these false religions, you have given Satan and his demons the legal right and permission to come into your life. By so doing you become a slave to their devices and you are deprived of your eternal life and the glorious crown.

You may want to at least know some of these false religions since there are zillions of them out there. Below are some of the widely known false religions and cults:

There are many false religions and cults out there; these are just a few of the many.

Advice: Stay away from Sunday worship or churches (Christianity), mystic and spiritism organizations, or sects. The Bible says, ***“Beware lest anyone cheat you through philosophy and empty deceit, according to the tradition of men, according to the basic principles of the world, and not according to Christ [the Messiah]” (Colossians 2:8).***

Let’s emphasize more on Occultism since it’s becoming more popular and its members are increasing rapidly.

Occultism: The word “occult” literally means “hidden”, which reveals how Satan and demons orchestrate their plans to enter into a person’s body. Occult always involves religious practices whose sources are not of Yahveh:

“There shall not be found among you anyone who makes his son or his daughter pass through the fire, or one who practices witchcraft, or a soothsayer, or one who interprets omens, or a sorcerer, or one who conjures spells, or a medium, or a spiritist, or one who calls up the dead. For all who do these things are an abomination to the LORD, and because of these abominations

the LORD your God drives them out from before you. You shall be blameless before the LORD your God. For these nations which you will dispossess listened to soothsayers and diviners; but as for you, the LORD your God has not appointed such for you” (Deuteronomy 18:10-14, see also 2 Kings 21:6-16).

Vows and oaths made during initiation into the occult or any mystic religion

Vows or oaths made during initiation into the occult or any false religion is known as demonic vow or oath. Demonic vows and oaths are spiritual signatures that the demons use as a legal right and permission to gain access into one’s life. Demonic vows and oaths can be made knowingly or unknowingly either by dabbling with the occult or just by reading forbidden materials including horoscopes give the demons your spiritual signature to get in on the inside of your body or draw closer to you.

What does the Bible say concerning demonic vows and oaths?

“Thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, saying: ‘You and your wives have spoken with your mouths and fulfilled with your hands, saying, “We will surely keep our vows that we have made, to burn incense to the queen of heaven and pour out drink offerings to her.” You will surely keep your vows and perform your vows!’ Therefore hear the word of the LORD, all Judah who dwell in the land of Egypt: ‘Behold, I have sworn by My great name,’ says the LORD, ‘that My name shall no more be named in the mouth of any man of Judah in all the land of Egypt, saying, “The Lord GOD lives.” Behold, I will watch over them for adversity and not for good. And all the men of Judah who are in the land of Egypt shall be consumed by the sword and by famine, until there is an end to them” (Jeremiah 44:25).

Dabbling with any area of the occult, seeing a fortuneteller, psychic, witch, wizard, sorcerer, or magician even one time, can open doors to demons hereby giving them the legal right and permission to torment you.

Demons can also go into you if you engage in any of the following occult practices:

1. Fortunetelling of any kind such as:
 - (a) Tea leaf reading
 - (b) Palm reading.
 - (c) Tarot cards reading.
 - (d) Crystal ball gazing
 - (e) Numerology.

- (f) Phrenology/neuroscience (fortune-telling by bumps on the head).
- (g) Irisology (fortune-telling by iris of eyes).
- (h) Water witching (divining or dowsing to find other things).
- (i) Psychometry (divination by objects).
- (j) Transcendental Meditation
- (k) Spirit of the glass
- (l) The use of Ouija boards
- 2. Reading of Occult books
- 3. Spelling out supernatural messages with Ouija Boards.
- 4. Automatic Writing
- 5. Séances (A meeting of spiritualists)
- 6. Astrology (telling the future by observing the time, reading the stars)
- 7. Horoscope Reading
- 8. Voodoo
- 9. Astral projection/ Out-of-body travel/ Out -of -body experience/Soul Travel.
- 10. Levitation (floating in the air),
- 11. Ventriloquism
- 12. Levitation.
- 13. I Ching (A Chinese classic text describing an ancient system of cosmology and philosophy).
- 14. Witchcraft
- 15. Wizardry
- 16. Satanism

What does the Bible say concerning witchcraft, sorcery, and the occult?

The Bible says:

“Thou shalt have no other gods before me. Thou shalt not bow down thyself to them, nor serve them: for I the LORD thy God am a jealous God, visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth generation of them that hate me. And showing mercy unto thousands of them that love me, and keep my commandments” (Exodus 20:3, 5, 6, KJV).

“Many who became believers confessed their sinful practices. A number of them who had been practicing magic brought their incantation books and burned them at a public bonfire. The value of the books was several million dollars. So the message about the Lord spread widely and had a powerful effect” (Acts 19:18, 19, NLT).

“For rebellion is as the sin of witchcraft, and stubbornness is as iniquity and idolatry. Because thou hast rejected the word of the LORD, he hath also rejected thee from being king” (1 Samuel 15:23, KJV).

“But there was a certain man, called Simon, which before time in the same city used sorcery, and bewitched the people of Samaria, giving out that himself was some great one: And to him, they had regard because that of a long time he had bewitched them with sorceries. Then Simon himself believed also: and when he was baptized, he continued with Philip, and wondered, beholding the miracles and signs which were done” (Acts 8:9, 11, and 13, KJV).

“Then Pharaoh also called the wise men and the sorcerers: now the magicians of Egypt, they also did in like manner with their enchantments” (Exodus 7:11, KJV).

“Therefore hearken not ye to your prophets, nor to your diviners, nor to your dreamers, nor to your enchanters, nor to your sorcerers, which speak unto you, saying, Ye shall not serve the king of Babylon” (Jeremiah 27:9, KJV).

“Then the king commanded to call the magicians, and the astrologers, and the sorcerers, and the Chaldeans, for to shew the king his dreams. So they came and stood before the king” (Daniel 2:2, KJV).

“And I will come near to you to judgment; and I will be a swift witness against the sorcerers” (Malachi 3:5, KJV).

“For without are dogs, and sorcerers, and whoremongers, and murderers, and idolaters, and whosoever loveth and maketh a lie” (Revelation 22:15, KJV).

“And he caused his children to pass through the fire in the valley of the son of Hinnom: also he observed times, and used enchantments, and used witchcraft, and dealt with a familiar spirit, and with wizards: he wrought much evil in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger” (2 Chronicles 33:6, KJV).

“Regard not them that have familiar spirits, neither seek after wizards, to be defiled by them: I am the LORD your God” (Leviticus 19:31, KJV).

“And the soul that turneth after such as has familiar spirits, and after wizards, to go a whoring after them, I will even set my face against that soul, and will cut him off from among his people” (Leviticus 20:6, KJV).

“And the woman said unto him, Behold, thou knowest what Saul hath done, how he hath cut off those that have familiar spirits, and the wizards, out of the land: wherefore then layest thou a snare for my life, to cause me to die?” (1 Samuel 28:9, KJV).

“Moreover the workers with familiar spirits, and the wizards, and the images, and the idols, and all the abominations that were spied in the land of Judah and in Jerusalem, did Josiah put away, that he might perform the words of the law which were written in the book that Hilkiah the priest found in the house of the LORD” (2 Kings 23:24, KJV).

“And when they shall say unto you, Seek unto them that have familiar spirits, and unto wizards that peep, and that mutter: should not a people seek unto their God? For the living to the dead?” (Isaiah 8:19, KJV).

“And the spirit of Egypt shall fail in the midst thereof: and I will destroy the counsel thereof: and they shall seek to the idols, and to the charmers, and to them that have familiar spirits, and to the wizards” (Isaiah 19:3, KJV).

“Which does not hear the voice of the snake charmer, or the chant of the clever magician” (Psalm 58:5, GNT).

“When thou art come into the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, thou shalt not learn to do after the abominations of those nations. There shall not be found among you any one that maketh his son or his daughter to pass through the fire, or that useth divination, or an observer

of times, or an enchanter, or a witch, or a charmer, or a consulter with familiar spirits, or a wizard, or a necromancer. For all that do these things are an abomination unto the LORD: and because of these abominations, the LORD thy God doth drive them out from before thee” (Deuteronomy 18:9-12, KJV).

“Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies... that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God” (Galatians 5:20, 21, KJV).

Entry Point #2: Sin

What Is Sin?

Sin is the transgression of Yahveh’s Law (1 John 3:4). Sin is also another way in which demons can enter your home and body.

Apparently, not all sins will cause demons to attack you. However, you may get into trouble if you get yourself in heavier sins for quite a long period of time without pulling out.

When you willfully or deliberately commit sin, you have legally given demons the right and permission to harass and sabotage your life. When you know an act is sinful and deliberately commit it, the heavens find it difficult to forgive you and this gives demons access to your body and/or attacks you. The Bible says, ***“If we deliberately keep on sinning after we have received the knowledge of the truth, no sacrifice for sins is left, but only a fearful expectation of judgment and of raging fire that will consume the enemies of God” (Hebrews 10:26, 27, NIV).***

The deeper the sin, the bigger the door opens for more demons to enter. When you make this willful sin a habit the demons move further to pressure you to commit more sins since the feelings and desires the demons push on you are irresistible.

Sin opens the door to demons, which push you in the direction to more sins, and opens you wider to more demons. The Bible gave an account of a man whose door was widely opened to many demons, ***“Jesus [Yahshua] asked him, saying, “What is your name?” And he said, “Legion,” because many demons had entered him” (Luke 8:30).***

What does the Bible say concerning willful sin?

The Bible says:

“And Jesus [Yahshua] said unto her, neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more” (John 8:11, KJV).

“Afterward Jesus [Yahshua] findeth him in the temple, and said unto him, Behold, thou art made whole: sin no more, lest a worse thing come unto thee” (John 5:14, KJV).

“Jesus [Yahshua] answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin” (John 8:34, KJV).

“Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that ye should obey it in the lusts thereof” (Romans 6:12, KJV)

“Neither yield ye your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God” (Romans 6:13, KJV).

“Know ye not, that to whom ye yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants ye are to whom ye obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness?” (Romans 6:16, KJV).

“But now being made free from sin, and become servants to God, ye have your fruit unto holiness, and the end everlasting life” (Romans 6:22, KJV).

“For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ [Yahshua the Messiah] our Lord” (Romans 6:23, KJV).

“Now if I do that I would not, it is no more I that do it, but sin that dwelleth in me” (Romans 7:20, KJV).

“And he that doubteth is damned if he eats, because he eateth not of faith: for whatsoever is not of faith is sin” (Romans 14:23, KJV).

“But when ye sin so against the brethren, and wound their weak conscience, ye sin against Christ [the Messiah]” (1 Corinthians 8:12, KJV).

“The sting of death is sin; and the strength of sin is the law” (1 Corinthians 15:56, KJV).

“For if we sin willfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins” (Hebrews 10:26, KJV).

“Then when lust hath conceived, it bringeth forth sin: and sin, when it is finished, bringeth forth death” (James 1:15, KJV).

“Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him it is sin” (James 4:17, KJV).

“Whosoever committeth sin transgresseth also the law: for sin is the transgression of the law” (1 John 3:4, KJV).

“He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning. For this purpose, the Son of God was manifested, that he might destroy the works of the devil” (1 John 3:8, KJV).

“Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him: and he cannot sin, because he is born of God” (1 John 3:9, KJV).

“All unrighteousness is sin” (1 John 5:17a, KJV).

Forms of Sin

There are various forms of sin that open doors to demons. Here are a few couples of them:

1. The Lust of the flesh

The Bible says:

“But put ye on the Lord Jesus Christ [Yahshua the Messiah], and make not provision for the flesh, to fulfill the lusts thereof” (Romans 13:14, KJV).

2. The Lust of the Eye

The Bible says:

“For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life is not of the Father, but is of the world. And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth forever” (1 John 2:16, 17, KJV).

“For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life is not of the Father but is of the world” (1 John 2:16, KJV).

3. Pride

The Bible says:

“When pride comes, then comes shame; but with the humble is wisdom” (Proverbs 11:2).

4. Drunkenness

The Bible says:

“Drinking too much makes you loud and foolish. It’s stupid to get drunk” (Proverbs 20:1GNT).

“Woe to those who rise early in the morning, that they may follow intoxicating drink; who continue until night, till wine inflames them! The harp and the strings, the tambourine and flute,

*and wine are in their feasts;
but they do not regard the work of the LORD, nor consider the operation of His hands” (Isaiah 5:11, 12).*

5. Illicit Drugs

When you indulge in or become addicted to illicit drugs such as cocaine, heroin, meth, marijuana, lysergic acid diethylamide (LSD), or anti-prescription drugs, the natural walls of defense in your physical, spiritual, and emotional system are *weakened* and it leaves you vulnerable for the demons to *attach* themselves to you. Illicit drugs *lower* your defenses, and since demons thrive on weakness, they will move in and set up camp.

What does the Bible say concerning illicit drugs?

The scriptures below are connected with the Greek word for drugs which were translated as sorcery and witchcraft. The Greek word for drugs in these scriptures is pharmakeia (#5332 in Strongs) and the name “pharmacy” was derived from this word.

The Bible says:

“Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; Adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, Idolatry, witchcraft [drugs], hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, envying, murders, drunkenness, reveling, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God” (Galatians 5:19-21, KJV).

“Neither repented they of their murders, nor of their sorceries, nor of their fornication, nor of their thefts” (Revelation 9:21, KJV).

“For thy merchants were the great men of the earth; for by thy sorceries were all nations deceived” (Revelation 18:23c, KJV).

“But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death” (Revelation 21:8, KJV).

6. Reveling

The Bible says:

“Envy, murders, drunkenness, reveling, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God” (Galatians 5:21).

“For the time past of our life may suffice us to have wrought the will of the Gentiles, when we walked in lasciviousness, lusts, excess of wine, reveling, banqueting, and abominable idolatries” (1 Peter 4:3).

7. Greediness (Covetous)

The Bible says:

“Moreover thou shalt provide out of all the people able men, such as fear God, men of truth, hating covetousness; and place such over them, to be rulers of thousands, and rulers of hundreds, rulers of fifties, and rulers of tens” (Exodus 18:21).

“The wicked in his proud countenance does not seek God; God is in none of his thoughts” (Psalms 10:4).

“The prince that wanteth understanding is also a great oppressor: but he that hateth covetousness shall prolong his days” (Proverbs 28:16).

8. Rails (complaining bitterly)

The Bible says:

“And they that passed by railed on him, wagging their heads, and saying, ah, thou that destroyest the temple, and buildest it in three days” (Mark 15:29).

“And one of the malefactors which were hanged railed on him, saying, If thou be Christ [the Messiah], save thyself and us” (Luke 23:39).

“But now I have written unto you not to keep company, if any man that is called a brother be a fornicator, or covetous, or an idolater, or a railer or a drunkard, or an extortioner; with such a one no not to eat” (1 Corinthians 5:11).

9. Slander/Libel

The Bible says:

“Lord, who may enter your Temple? Who may worship on Zion, your sacred hill? Those who do not slander others. They do no wrong to their friends nor spread rumours about their neighbour” (Psalm 15:1, 3 GNT).

“He that hideth hatred with lying lips, and he that uttereth a slander, is a fool” (Proverbs 10:18).

“Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers, backbiters, slanders, haters of God, despiteful, proud, boasters, inventors of evil things, disobedient to parents” (Romans 1:29, 30).

10. Anger and Resentment (Wrath)

The Bible says:

“To worry yourself to death with resentment would be foolish, senseless thing to do” (Job 5:2).

“Cease from anger, and forsake wrath: fret not thyself in any wise to do evil” (Psalms 37:8).

“Riches profit not in the day of wrath: but righteousness delivereth from death” (Proverbs 11:4).

“He that is slow to anger is better than the mighty; and he that ruleth his spirit than he that taketh a city” (Proverbs 16:32).

11. Bitterness

The Bible says:

“Whose mouth is full of cursing and bitterness” (Romans 3:14).

“Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord: Looking diligently lest any man fails of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble you, and thereby many be defiled” (Hebrews 12:14, 15).

12. Hatred (hateful feelings)

The Bible says:

“Hatred stirreth up strifes: but love covereth all sins” (Proverbs 10:12).

“He that hideth hatred with lying lips, and he that uttereth a slander, is a fool” (Proverbs 10:18).

“Whose hatred is covered by deceit, his wickedness shall be shewed before the whole congregation” (Proverbs 26:26).

“Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies... that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God” (Galatians 5:20, 21).

“For we ourselves also were sometimes foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving divers lusts and pleasures, living in malice and envy, hateful, and hating one another” (Titus 3:3).

13. Unforgiving

The Bible says:

“Take heed to yourselves: If thy brother trespass against thee, rebuke him; and if he repents, forgive him. And if he trespasses against thee seven times in a day, and seven times in a day turn again to thee, saying, I repent; thou shalt forgive him” (Luke 17:3, 4).

“For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: But if ye forgive not men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses” (Matthew 6:14, 15).

14. Strife

The Bible says:

“A wrathful man stirreth up strife: but he that is slow to anger appeaseth strife” (Proverbs 15:18).

“Better is a dry morsel, and quietness therewith, than a house full of sacrifices with strife” (Proverbs 17:1).

“It is an honour for a man to cease from strife: but every fool will be meddling” (Proverbs 20:3).

“Cast out the scorner, and contention shall go out; yea, strife, and reproach shall cease” (Proverbs 22:10).

“He that passeth by, and meddleth with strife belonging not to him, is like one that taketh a dog by the ears” (Proverbs 26:17).

“He that is of a proud heart stirreth up strife: but he that putteth his trust in the LORD shall be made fat” (Proverbs 28:25).

“An angry man stirreth up strife, and a furious man aboundeth in transgression” (Proverbs 29:22).

15. Variance and Emulations

The Bible says:

“Idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies... that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God” (Galatians 5:20, 21).

16. Malice

The Bible says:

“Being filled with all unrighteousness, fornication, wickedness, covetousness, maliciousness; full of envy, murder, debate, deceit, malignity; whisperers... Who knowing the judgment of God, that they which commit such things are worthy of death, not only do the same, but have pleasure in them that do them” (Romans 1:29, 32).

“Let all bitterness, and wrath, and anger, and clamour, and evil speaking, be put away from you, with all malice” (Ephesians 4:31).

“But now ye also put off all these; anger, wrath, malice, blasphemy, filthy communication out of your mouth” (Colossians 3:8).

CHAPTER 4

The Harm Demons Can Cause

More than One Demon

In some cases, more than one demon can enter into the same victim. Here are some accounts from the Holy Scriptures:

The Man at Gadarenes

“Then they came to the other side of the sea, to the country of the Gadarenes. And when He had come out of the boat, immediately there met Him out of the tombs a man with an unclean spirit, who had his dwelling among the tombs; and no one could bind him, not even with chains, because he had often been bound with shackles and chains. And the chains had been pulled apart by him, and the shackles broken in pieces; neither could anyone tame him. And always, night and day, he was in the mountains and in the tombs, crying out and cutting himself with stones. When he saw Jesus [Yahshua] from afar, he ran and worshiped Him. And he cried out with a loud voice and said, what have I to do with You, Jesus [Yahshua), Son of the Most High God? I implore You by God that You do not torment me. For He said to him, “Come out of the man, unclean spirit!” Then He asked him, “What is your name?” And he answered, saying, My name is Legion; for we are many” (Mark 5:1-9).

Mary Magdalene

“And the twelve were with Him, and certain women who had been healed of evil spirits and infirmities—Mary called Magdalene, out of whom had come seven demons” (Luke 8:1, 2).

Cause Mental Disease

Demons can inflict mental diseases. As in the case of the man at Gadarene: “... *because he had often been bound with shackles and chains. And the chains had been pulled apart by him, and the shackles broken in pieces; neither could anyone tame him. And always, night and day, he was in the mountains and in the tombs, crying out and cutting himself with stones*” (Mark 5:4, 5).

Physical Deformity

Yahshua healed a woman with a physical deformity that was caused by a demon: “*And behold, there was a woman who had a spirit of infirmity eighteen years, and was bent over and could in no way raise herself up. But when Jesus saw her, He called her to Him and said to her, “Woman, you are loosed from your infirmity.” And He laid His hands on her, and immediately she was made straight, and glorified God. So ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan has bound—think of it—for eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the Sabbath?*” (Luke 13:11-13, 16).

Muteness/Blindness

Demons can stop someone from using their powers of speech and sight. The Bible says, “*As they went out, behold, they brought to Him a man, mute and demon-possessed. And when the demon was cast out, the mute spoke*” (Matthew 9:32, 33). Again the Bible says, “*Then one was brought to Him who was demon-possessed, blind and mute; and He healed him, so that the blind and mute man both spoke and saw*” (Matthew 12:22).

Cause Erratic Behavior

Under the influence of demons, a victim could behave strangely. The Bible says, “*And when they had come to the multitude, a man came to Him, kneeling down to Him and saying, “Lord, have mercy on my son, for he is an epileptic and suffers severely; for he often falls into the fire*

and often into the water. And Jesus [Yahshua] rebuked the demon, and it came out of him; and the child was cured from that very hour” (Matthew 17:14, 15, 18).

Hurt Unbelievers

Demons have the power to hurt unbelievers likewise the lukewarm believers and the cold believers.

The Bible gives us an account of unbelievers being harmed by demons. The Bible says, *“Then some of the itinerant Jewish exorcists took it upon themselves to call the name of the Lord Jesus over those who had evil spirits, saying, we exorcise you by the Jesus whom Paul preaches. Also there were seven sons of Sceva, a Jewish chief priest, who did so. And the evil spirit answered and said, Jesus I know, and Paul I know; but who are you? Then the man in whom the evil spirit was leaped on them, ^[c]overpowered them, and prevailed against them, so that they fled out of that house naked and wounded” (Acts 19:13-16).*

Deceive Kings and Nations

Entire kings and nations can be deceived by the influence of demons.

The Bible says, *“And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs coming out of the mouth of the dragon, out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet. For they are spirits of demons, performing signs, which go out to the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty” (Revelation 16:13-14).*

Note:

It must be stressed that the power of demons is limited. Their ability to harm believers is kept under control by the Almighty Yahveh. Though demons' power is far-reaching, it can only be exercised within limits.


CHAPTER 5

The 7 Steps to Casting Out Demons

Now that you know the harm demons could cause, if you're affected or are under the attacks and manipulations of demons, then it's time to prepare yourself to battle these wicked forces and finally cast them out of your life.

Step #1

Surrender Your Body and Soul to Yahveh Our Creator.



*“Surrender your whole being to him to be used for righteous purposes”
(Romans 6:13b GNT).*

In today's world, the word 'surrender' is always used in a negative context. No one wants to be a loser, admit defeat, yield, or surrender to an opponent. But surrendering to God is the heart of worship.

You must give yourself to God, not out of fear or duty but in love because he first loved you (1 John 4:10, 19). The Apostle Paul urges us to fully surrender to God. Paul said, ***“I beseech you, therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service”*** (Romans 12:1).

This act of personal surrender is consecrating yourself, making Yahshua the Messiah your Lord, taking up your stake (cross), dying to self, and yielding to the Holy Spirit. Yahveh wants your life, all of it. Ninety-nine percent is not enough.

The three barriers that can block your total surrender to Yahveh are *fear, pride, and confusion*.

I. Fear: Can I Trust God?

The first barrier to total surrender is fear, but the essential ingredient to surrender is trust. You won't surrender to Yahveh unless you trust him, but you can't trust him until you know him better. Fear keeps us from surrendering, but love casts out all fear. The more you realize how much Yahveh loves you, the easier surrender becomes. Surrounding your to God brings freedom and not bondage.

II. Pride: Should I Admit My Limitation?

The second barrier to total surrender is pride. Humans don't want to admit that we are just creatures and not in charge of everything. It is the oldest temptation: ***“You will be like God!*** (*Genesis 3:5*). The desire to have absolute control is the cause of so much trouble in our lives. Life is a struggle, but what most people don't realize is that our struggle is really a struggle with Yahveh! We want to be Yahveh, and there is no way we are going to win that struggle.

According to A.W. Tozer, *“The reason why many are still troubled, still seeking, still making little forward progress is because they haven't yet come to the end of themselves. We're still trying to give orders, and interfering with God's work within us.”*

You aren't Yahveh and never will you be. You are a human. It is when you try to be Yahveh that you end up most like Satan, who desired the same thing. Accept your humanity intellectually, but not emotionally.

When you are faced with your own limitation, do not react with resentment, anger, and irritation. Do not desire the ability to have it all and do it all or else you will be disappointed and become upset because it will not happen. And when you notice that God has given others characteristics you don't have, don't react with envy, jealousy, and self-pity.

III. Confusion: What does it mean to surrender?

Surrounding your life to Yahveh may not seem what you may be thinking. Surrendering to Yahveh isn't fatalism, passive resignation, or an excuse for laziness. It means sacrificing your life or suffering to change what needs to be changed. Again, surrendering is not for cowards or doormats. It does not mean giving up rational thinking. Yahveh would not waste the mind he gave you. Surrounding is not suppressing your personality. Yahveh wants to use your unique personality, rather than its being diminished, surrendering rather enhances it. C. S. Lewis said, *“The more we let God take us over, the more truly ourselves we become — because he made us. He invented all the different people that you and I were intended to be.... It is when I turn to Jesus Christ (Hebrew: Yahshua Ha Mashiach), when I give up myself to His personality, that I first begin to have a real personality of my own.”*

Demonstrate surrendering in obedience. Say yes to whatever Yahveh asked of you. Surrounded people obey God's word, even if it doesn't make sense.

Trust is also another aspect of a fully surrendered life. Our father Abraham followed Yahveh's leading without knowing *where* it would take him. Hannah also waited for Yahveh's perfect timing without knowing *when*. Mary expected a miracle without knowing *how*. Joseph trusted Yahveh's purpose without knowing why circumstances happened the way they did. Each of these people was fully surrendered to Yahveh.

You are surrendered to Yahveh when you rely on him to work things out instead of trying to manipulate others, force your will, agenda, and control the situation. You let go of and allow Yahveh to work. Let Yahveh be "in charge" of your life. The Bible says, "***Surrender yourself to the Lord, and wait patiently for him***" (*Psalm 37:7a GWT*). You have to surrender yourself to Yahveh's plan, just as Yahshua surrendered himself to Yahveh's plan. Yahshua prayed, "***Father, everything is possible for you. Please take this cup of suffering away from. Yet I want your will, not mine***" (*Mark 14:36, NLT*).

Pastor Rick Warren said, "*Genuine surrender says, 'Father, if this problem, pain, sickness, or circumstance is needed to fulfill your purpose and glory in my life or another's, please don't take it away.' This level of maturity does not come easy.*"

There is a blessing that comes with surrendering your life to Yahveh.

First, you experience perfect peace. The Bible says, "***Stop quarreling with God! If you agree with him, you will have peace at last, and things will go well for you***" (*Job 22:2, NLT*).

Second, you experience total freedom. The Bible says, "***Offer yourselves to the ways of God and the freedom never quits.... his commands set you free to live openly in his freedom!***" (*Romans 6:17, MSG*)

Thirdly, you experience Yahveh's power in your life. The Bible says, "***He giveth power to the faint; and to them that have no might he increaseth strength... they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint***" (*Isaiah 40:29-31*).

Note this, victory comes through surrender. Surrender doesn't weaken you; it strengthens you. When surrendering to God you don't have to fear. You also don't have to surrender to anything else. William Booth, the founder of the Salvation Army, said, "*The Greatness of a man's power is in the measure of his surrender.*" The Bible says, "***So give yourselves completely to God***" (*James 4:7a, NCV*).

Everybody eventually surrenders to someone or something. If not to Yahveh, you will surrender to the opinions or expectations of others, to money, to resentment, to fear, or to your own pride, lusts, and ego. You were created to worship Yahveh and if you fail to worship him, you will create other things such as an idol to give your life to. You are free to choose what you surrender to, but you are not free from the consequences of that choice. E. Stanley Jones said, "*If you don't surrender to Christ [appropriate word: the Messiah], you surrender to chaos.*"

Pastor Rick Warren again said, *“Surrender is not the best way to live; it is the only way to live. Nothing else works. All other approaches lead to frustration, disappointment, and self-destruction.”*

Your past regrets, your present problems, your future ambitions, your fears, dreams, weaknesses, habits, hurts, and hang-ups, give it all to Almighty Yahveh. Put Yahshua the Messiah in the driver’s seat of your life and take your hands off the steering wheel and let everything be under his control, for with him nothing can be out of control.

You have to surrender your life every day. Make it a daily habit. Yahshua said, ***“If people want to follow me, they must give up the things they want. They must be willing to give up their lives daily to follow me”*** (Luke 9:23, NCV).

Let me inform you: when you decide to live a surrendered life, that decision will be tested. At times it will mean doing unpopular, costly, inconvenient, or impossible tasks. It will also mean doing the opposite of what you feel like doing. Now is your time to surrender to Yahveh’s wisdom, love, and grace. The Bible says, ***“Surrender your whole being to him to be used for righteous purposes”*** (Romans 6:13b GNT).

Pray this prayer:

My Lord and Savior Yahshua Ha Mashiach, I surrender all my life to you. I give up my pride, will, arrogance, selfishness, self-willed, self-interest, self-promotion, self-exaltation, lustful desires, and greediness. I live not by my will any longer. My will is death, but yours is living in eternity. From now onward my mind, my thought, my brain, my body, my soul, my spirit, and my whole life belong to you. I give them all to you, use me as you wish. Now I live for you and only you for the rest of my life. So help me Yahveh. Amen.

Step #2

Confession of Sins

Your body gateways were opened as a result of sin or ignorantly following a ritual practice. Therefore you have to confess to Yahveh known and unknown sins you have committed so he can forgive you. The Bible says, ***“Come now, and let us reason together, says the LORD, though your sins are like scarlet, they shall be as white as snow; though they are red like crimson, they shall be as wool”*** (Isaiah 1:18).

Again, The Bible says, ***“As I live,’ says the Lord GOD, ‘I have no pleasure in the death of the wicked, but that the wicked turn from his way and live. Turn, turn from your evil ways! For why should you die, O house of Israel? Again, when I say to the wicked, ‘You shall surely die,’ if he turns from his sin and does what is lawful and right, if the wicked restores the***

pledge, gives back what he has stolen, and walks in the statutes of life without committing iniquity, he shall surely live; he shall not die. None of his sins which he has committed shall be remembered against him; he has done what is lawful and right; he shall surely live” (Ezekiel 33:11, 14-16).

Confessing your sins is a must if you want to cast out demons from your body or the body of another victim. The Bible says, *“If you would prepare your heart, and stretch out your hands toward Him; if iniquity were in your hand, and you put it far away, and would not let wickedness dwell in your tents; then surely you could lift up your face without spot; yes, you could be steadfast, and not fear; because you would forget your misery, and remember it as waters that have passed away, and your life would be brighter than noonday. Though you were dark, you would be like the morning. And you would be secure, because there is hope; yes, you would dig around you, and take your rest in safety. You would also lie down, and no one would make you afraid; yes, many would court your favor” (Job 11:13-19).*

Confess your sins by praying the following prayer out loud:

My Heavenly Father Yahveh, to you I have done an abominable thing by sinning and has deliberately opened my gateways through a forbidden ritual and sins. I deserve to be punished for the rest of my life but I know that you’re a loving father who does not delight in destroying your children. Therefore I come to you for forgiveness. Please forgive me and wash me with the precious blood of Yahshua the Messiah. Make me whole again. Descend your righteous spirit upon me. Fill me with your spirit and strength. Guard me with your loving-kindness. Thank you, Father, for your forgiveness. In Yahshua’s name, I commit my body and soul into your hands. Amen.

Recite the following confession psalms loudly:

Psalm 51

Have mercy upon me, O Yahveh, according to Your loving-kindness; according to the multitude of Your tender mercies, blot out my transgressions.

Wash me thoroughly from my iniquity, and cleanse me from my sin. For I acknowledge my transgressions, and my sin is always before me.

Against You, You only, have I sinned, and done this evil in Your sight—That You may be found just when You speak, and blameless when You judge.

Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, and in sin my mother conceived me.

Behold, You desire truth in the inward parts, and in the hidden part You will make me to know wisdom.


Purge me with hyssop, and I shall be clean; wash me, and I shall be whiter than snow.
Make me hear joy and gladness, that the bones You have broken may rejoice.
Hide Your face from my sins, and blot out all my iniquities.
Create in me a clean heart, O Yahveh, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.
Do not cast me away from Your presence, and do not take Your Holy Spirit from me.
Restore to me the joy of Your salvation, and uphold me by Your generous Spirit.
Then I will teach transgressors Your ways, and sinners shall be converted to You.
Deliver me from the guilt of bloodshed, O Yahveh, the God of my salvation, and my tongue shall sing aloud of Your righteousness.
O Yahveh, open my lips, and my mouth shall show forth Your praise.
For You do not desire sacrifice, or else I would give *it*; You do not delight in burnt offering.
The sacrifices of Yahveh *are* a broken spirit, a broken and a contrite heart—These, O Yahveh, You will not despise.

Psalm 130

Out of the depths I have cried to You, O YAHVEH; Lord, hear my voice!
Let Your ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications.
If You, YAHVEH, should mark iniquities, O Yahveh, who could stand?
But there is forgiveness with You, that You may be feared.
I wait for Yahveh, my soul waits, and in His word I do hope.
My soul waits for Yahveh more than those who watch for the morning—Yes, more than those who watch for the morning.
I have hope in Yahveh: for with Yahveh there is mercy, and with him is abundant redemption.
And he shall redeem me from all my iniquities.

Step #3

Preparation



“If you would prepare your heart, and stretch out your hands toward Him... you could be steadfast, and not fear” (Job 11:13, 15).

The Bible says, ***“How can one enter a strong man’s house and plunder his goods, unless he first binds the strong man? And then he will plunder his house” (Matthew 12:29).***

A soldier does not go to war without preparation. Therefore, a believer should also not go to war with demons and Satan without preparing.

In your preparation to battle demons, you have to put on the whole armor of the Almighty Yahveh. Without the saint’s armor, you’ll be defenseless. The Bible says, ***“Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord and in the power of His might. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and having shod your feet with the preparation of the gospel of peace; above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints” (Ephesian 6:10-18).***

For deep meaning into the saint’s armor and how to arm yourself with these protective armors, order this book that goes by the title, *“Spiritual Battles: How to Win Your Battles Over Satan and Demons.”*

Do Away If Fear

One thing that can stop you from preparing for the battle is “fear”, and fear is a weapon of Satan. Satan always instills fear in people so that they can’t prepare to face him or take action against him. Satan is like the lion that roars to instill fear in its prey to be able to devour them. Just as a lion’s roar strikes terror in the hearts of those who hear it, so Satan and demons use fear to

paralyze their victims. The Bible says, ***“Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour” (1 Peter 5:8).***

You cannot be prepared for battle if your mind and heart are not prepared. You must prepare your mind and heart with the hope of victory. Affirm or speak to yourself several times that “you’re a winner and your enemies have already been defeated”

Fear weakens you and causes you to be *self-centered* and *clouds* your mind so that all you can think about is the thing that frightens you. However, fear can only control you if you allow it. Your Creator Yahveh does not want you to be a slave to anything. The Apostle Paul said, ***“All things are lawful for me, but all things are not helpful. All things are lawful for me, but I will not be brought under the power of any.” (1 Corinthians 6:12).*** You have only one master and that master is Yahshua the Messiah. Yahshua said, ***“You call me Teacher and Lord, and you say well, for so I am.” (John 13:13 see 2 Timothy 2:21).*** You were not created or called to be oppressed by fear. God created you as a free person. It is the enemy who is holding you hostage. The Bible says, ***“For you did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, Abba,[a Father.” (Romans 8:15).*** Another Scripture says ***“For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.” (2 Timothy 1:7).***

If you have realized that you have been consumed by the spirit of fear, pray this prayer:

My Beloved Father, Yahveh, I confess to you that I have listened to the devil’s roar and focused on my feelings and conditions and have allowed fear to consume me. Yahveh, please forgive me. I renounce the spirit of fear and affirm your truth that you have given me the spirit of adoption, love, power, and sound mind. Please, Father, bring to my mind all the fears that have been controlling me to renounce them and walk freely in your faith and everlasting love. Thank you for the gift of life you have given me to walk by faith and not by fear. In Yahshua Ha Mashiach’s name, I pray. Amein.

Fear is one of the tactics Satan and demons use to intimidate you and rob you of your faith in God and drive you to get your needs met through the world or the flesh rather than God, your Creator.

The following list will help you to recognize some of the fears that have been controlling your life all this while:

- * Fear of embarrassment
- * Fear of failure
- * Fear of divorce
- * Fear of illness
- * Fear of never loving or being loved by others
- * Fear of death
- * Fear of poverty

- * Fear of rejection
- * Fear of Satan/demons
- * Fear of the future
- * Fear of disapproval
- * The fear of never getting married
- * The fear of owing
- * The fear of being in a sinful act
- * The fear of pain
- * The fear of losing eternal life
- * The fear of committing the unforgivable sin
- * The fear of being a victim to a spirit spouse
- * The fear of being victimized by crime
- * The fear of confrontation
- * The fear of being a hopeless person

Pick the ones that apply to your life. Add any other one that the Holy Spirit brings to your mind. Then, one by one, renounce those fears out loud using the suggested renunciation below:

I renounce the (name the fear) because I am a child of Yahveh and I have been given the power and authority by Yahveh to renounce the spirit of fear out of my life. From today onwards, I have chosen to live in faith and in the truth of God. I am a free person now in the Messiah Yahshua, am no longer a slave of fear. So be it.

Step #4

Break All Legal Rights and Permissions of Demons

Legal rights and permissions of demons are carnal, physical, or spiritual activities of a person which allow demons to get in on the inside or outside of the person to attack or harass the person.

One thing you should know is that Satan and his minions do not have any right over human beings other than that which we have given to them. Of course, some people give Satan and demons the right to legally claim or possess them, when they indulge in sin and unholy life.

Sometimes, we, humankind give demons the right to claim others when we curse them. Though you may lead a blameless and honest life, others can demonize you by cursing you intentionally or accidentally — both works as both are legally valid and in doing so, open a gateway or door for evil spirits to possess or claim you.

Marine spirits, sex demons of the night, perverse spirits, evil spirits, incubus, and succubus cannot enter in on the inside of a person's body or soul without a specific reason. Our God is a God of perfect order and logic.

If evil spirits can get in on the inside of a person's body or soul just like that or at any time without any logical or specific reason, then we would all be possessed or have demons living inside us 24/7.

The bottom line of this issue is that Satan and demons cannot enter into a person's body or soul without having some kind of *legal right and permission*. Evil spirits need some kind of an *entry point or gateway* to be able to get into you, and that entry point will be their *door opener*.

The presence of demons in your life is a result of a legal right they are holding onto. You can't achieve a complete and successful deliverance without removing or breaking these legal rights. And once all the legal rights and permissions of demons are properly taken care of and broken, they will have absolutely nothing else left to hold onto, and they will be much easier to be cast out.

To break the legal rights and permissions of Satan and demons is to RENOUNCE (*verbally reject*) any involvement with occult practices, sorcery, witchcraft, idol worship, cult teachings, rituals, ungodly and false religions.

Do not hesitate to renounce any group or activity that denies that Yahshua the Messiah is the true son of Yahveh and came to die to pay the penalty of your sins and to set you free. The Bible says, "***For many deceivers are entered into the world, who confess not that Jesus Christ [Yahshua the Messiah] is come in the flesh. This is a deceiver and an antichrist [anti-messiah]***" (2 John 1:7, KJV). Another Scripture says, "***And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ [Yahshua the Messiah] is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist [anti-messiah], whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world***" (1 John 4:3, KJV).

Renounce any group or activity which offers guidance through any source other than our absolute authority, the Holy Bible. Also, renounce any organization or association that requires dark, secret initiations, ceremonies, promises, or pacts.

Pray this prayer if you want the Holy Spirit to remind you of all the evil activities or initiations you have partaken or watched:

Almighty Yahveh please let your Holy Spirit bring to my mind anything that I have done consciously or unconsciously that entails ritualism, cult, occult, enchantments, ungodly and false teachings or practices. I want to receive your freedom by renouncing these things right now. Help me now, O Yahveh, the revealer of hidden things. Amein.

Once you have remembered everything, confess and renounce everything you have been involved in by praying the following prayer out loud and fill in the blanks with the groups, teachings, or practices that the Holy Spirit has reminded you to renounce:

Ava Yahveh, I have regretted every evil act I have committed or get myself involved in and I now confess that I am guilty by participating in _____ (name the activity). Please forgive me and accept me back. I renounce any involvement with _____ (name the activity), and I terminate any legal ground that the enemy may hold against me. In Yahshua's name, I renounce. Amein.

You should also RENOUNCE every lie Satan, demons or any person have told you and believe the truth that Yahshua came to die to set you free from the powers of darkness.

The Bible says, *“Giving thanks unto the Father, which hath made us meet to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in light: Who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of his dear Son: In whom we have redemption through his blood, even the forgiveness of sins” (Colossians 1:12-14)*. The Holy Bible again says, *“Therefore if any man be in Christ [the Messiah], he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new. And all things are of God, who hath reconciled us to himself by Jesus Christ [Yahshua the Messiah], and hath given to us the ministry of reconciliation” (2 Corinthians 5:17, 18)*. Another Scripture says, *“For ye are dead, and your life is hid with Christ [the Messiah] in God” (Colossians 3:3)*.

Satan is the father of all lies, and he seeks to keep people in damage through deception, but it is the truth in Yahshua the Messiah that set us free (John 8:32, 44).

You need to accept the truth of God in the innermost part of your being (Psalm 51:6). Yahshua the Messiah is the truth you seek and you must believe in him because in him is all truths found (John 14:6). The Holy Spirit of Yahveh is the spirit of truth that you must not abandon (John 16:13). The Word of Yahveh is the truth, therefore, you ought to speak the truth in love (John 17:17).

You will find real joy and freedom when you stop living a lie and walk openly in the truth. The Bible says, *“Blessed [happy] is the man unto whom the LORD imputeth, not iniquity, and in whose spirit there is no guile [deceit]” (Psalm 32:2, KJV)*.

The god of this world, Satan, has so many ways of deceiving people. Even as he did with Eve (the first woman created), the devil tries to convince us to rely on ourselves and to try to get our needs met through the world around us, rather than trusting in the provision of our Maker in heaven.

Check each area of deception which the Holy Spirit brings to your mind and confess it, using the prayer below:

Father Yahveh, I admit that I have been deceived by (name the deceit). Please, Father, forgive me for accepting a lie and living a lie. I commit myself to believe and accept only your truth. Thank you for your forgiveness. In Yahshua's name, I pray. Amein.

Pray this prayer fervently and all legal rights and permissions will be broken instantly:

Ava Yahveh, you are the King of kings, the Lord of lords, the Omnipotent, the Omnipresent, the Omniscient, the First and the Last, I call on you to come to my aid for I am weak to defend and save myself. I am nothing without you. Send down your lightning power to break all legal rights and permissions of Satan and demons in my life. Destroy any evidence they may hold against me and set me free. Destroy all legal rights and permissions the enemy holds against me. Strengthen me to stand firm. Help me to stay away from any sinful act that may give these demons the legal right to possess me, attack me, or come into my life again. Put me under your shadow and protection. Open my eyes; grant me wisdom and insight so that I may not fall into the traps or tricks of Satan and demons anymore. Bind all these demons so that they may not come into my life again. Help me to live a responsible life for the rest of my life. In Yahshua's name, I pray. Amein.

Step #5

Fasting and Prayer

What is fasting?

Fasting is giving up food, and water (or something else) for a period of time to focus your thoughts on Yahveh.

During the fasting period, you should read the Holy Scriptures, pray, or meditate on the word of Yahveh.

Fasting is mentioned in both the Old and New Testaments. Fasting is also a way of expressing grief and a means of humbling yourself before your creator (see Psalm 35:13). Throughout the Holy Scriptures, fasting and prayer are often mentioned together. Acts 13:3 says, ***“Then, having fasted and prayed...”*** In Luke 2:37 a widow served Yahveh with fasting and prayers night and day.

What is prayer?

Prayer is the words you say to Yahveh. It is your way of communicating your needs, desires, and thoughts to Yahveh.

Prayer is a two-edged sword. One edge has the power to construct (create) and the other has the power to destroy. Prayer is a great weapon of construction and destruction.

What Fasting and Prayer Can Do For Your Spiritual Life

Do not *underestimate* the power of fasting and prayer. The Bible says, ***“So then, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, so that you will be healed. The prayer of a good person has a powerful effect. Elijah was the same kind of person as we are. He prayed earnestly that there would be no rain, and no rain fell on the land for three and a half years. Once again he prayed, and the sky poured out its rain and the earth produced the crops”*** (James 5:16-18, TEV).

The Bible again says, ***“However, this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting”*** (Matthew 17:21).

Fasting and prayer are some of the greatest weapons of believers that aid us in our war against Satan and his minions. The Bible says, ***“The weapons we use in our fight are not the worlds’ weapons but God’s powerful weapons which, we use to destroy strongholds. We destroy false arguments; we pull down every proud obstacle that is raised against the knowledge of God (Yahveh); we take every thought captive and make it obey Christ (Yahshua)”*** (2 Corinthians 10:4-5, TEV).

Here are some 5 things fasting can do for your spiritual life

(a) Fasting and prayer overcome your enemies. The Bible says, ***“Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this age, against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. Therefore take up the whole armor of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand”*** (Ephesians 6:11-13).

(b) Fasting and prayer defeat and cast out demons. The Bible says, ***“When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick”*** (Matthew 8:16, see Matthew 8:28-32). Again, the Bible says, ***“And behold, a woman of Canaan came from that region and cried out to Him, saying, have mercy on me, O Lord, Son of David! My daughter is severely demon-possessed. Then Jesus answered and said to her, O woman, great is your faith! Let it be to you as you desire. And her daughter was healed from that very hour”*** (Matthew 15:22, 28, see also Mark 9:14-29).

(c) Fasting and prayer draw you closer to your Creator Yahveh. The Bible says, ***“Draw near to God and He will draw near to you”*** (James 4:8).

(d) Fasting and prayer build our faith and keep it alive.

(e) Fasting and prayer help you hear from Yahveh. The Bible says, ***“Now this is the confidence that we have in Him, that if we ask anything according to His will, He hears us. And if we***

know that He hears us, whatever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we have asked of Him” (1 John 5:14, 15).

This step requires every victim to fast for 7 days but if you can't do the 7 days, then I recommend a minimum of 3 days. Start your fasting from 6 p.m. after your evening meal (supper) to 6 p.m. the next day at sunset before taking in another meal. And always remember to pray fervently during this fasting period.

Fruits to Avoid Before and After Breaking Your Fast

Avoid fruits that contain acids such as orange, pineapple, and others. Acidic or citrus fruits have a low pH, meaning they are acidic. Citrus and other acidic foods may contribute to symptoms in those with upper gastrointestinal issues like an ulcer or reflux.

Here's a list of fruits and their pH from Clemson University. They are listed from most acidic to least:

1. Lemon juice (pH: 2.00–2.60)
2. Limes (pH: 2.00–2.80)
3. Blue plums (pH: 2.80–3.40)
4. Grapes (pH: 2.90–3.82)
5. Pomegranates (pH: 2.93–3.20)
6. Grapefruits (pH: 3.00–3.75)
7. Blueberries (pH: 3.12–3.33)
8. Pineapples (pH: 3.20–4.00)
9. Apples (pH: 3.30–4.00)
10. Peaches (pH: 3.30–4.05)

11. Oranges (pH: 3.69–4.34)

12. Tomatoes (pH: 4.30–4.90)

When you fast and pray, you are taking time away from a meal or an activity to devote your entire being to focus on Yahveh. You will become more sensitive to the voice of Yahveh, and more attuned to hearing what Yahveh has to reveal to you. Yahveh will gently whisper in your mind what you were really thinking at the time of your sin and what your true purpose was and for a moment.

Step #6

Commanding Demons to Come Out

Use powerful words to battle the demons

There is power in words. And if you know how to use powerful words to your advantage, you will win victory over Satan and his demons any time they try to attack you.

Use the battle words or utterances written in my book titled: “*Spiritual Battles (Volume 3): How to Win Your Battles Over Satan and Demons*” to fight the demons residing in your body. And to your surprise, you will notice the power of such battle words.

I have listed many battle words or utterances that cover literally any kind of battle situation you may find yourself facing in this life.

Note this:

* The battle words or utterances will put fear into these demons and really help you to completely drive them out of your life or the life of another.

* As soon as you start quoting these battle words or making these battle utterances directly against these demons, the Holy Spirit will move very powerfully against these demons and overcome them for you — you will be set free.

* These battle words or utterances will give you maximum ammunition to use against any demon or evil spirit you may have to engage within your life. Use these tremendously powerful battle words or utterances in conjunction with the *saints’ armor (the armor of God)* and no demon or evil spirit will be able to withstand this kind of an attack.

Now engage directly with the demons that are occupying your seven chakras or gateways with the power of the spirit of righteousness that Yahveh has descended upon you.

Shout at the demons with a deep strong voice to immediately come out of your body and soul and they will yield to your command.

Pray this prayer loudly to command the demons to come out of your body immediately:

Satan, demons, or any evil spirit residing in me as a result of my chakras being opened to you, I renounce any covenant I have with you, spirits. I declare to you spirits that I am now a child of the Most High Yahveh and I am covered by the precious blood of Yahshua the Messiah. The heavenly and earthly authority has been given to me by my Father Yahveh to cast all of you out of my body. [Shout]: (With the power of Yahveh vested in me I command you Satan, demons, and all evil spirits to come out of my body and soul right now in the name of Yahshua Ha Mashiach. Live now and be perished forever. Never return.) Almighty Yahveh, descend your cleansing agent to clean my body and soul from all filthiness and make me holy. Thank you, Yahveh for setting me free. In Yahshua's name, I pray. Amein.

Step #7

Close and Seal Your Body Gateways

You need to come to a state where Satan and his minions have nothing in you that they can grip and pull you away from Yahveh's truth, peace and salvation. Yahshua said, ***"I will no longer talk much with you, for the ruler of this world is coming, and he has nothing in Me (John 14:30).*** In your deliverance journey, here comes the phase, you will have nothing in common with demons, and there will be nothing in you that will belong to them and they cannot exhibit power over you. John 14:30, the Amplified Version states: ***"I will not talk with you much more, for the prince (evil genius, ruler) of the world is coming. And he has no claim on Me. (He has nothing in common with Me; there is nothing in Me that belongs to him, and he has no power over Me.)"***

To remain spiritually and physically healthy, you have to have control over your body, soul, and life. You can heal yourself. Just believe you can and you will surely heal yourself from demonic attacks and damages. The Bible says, ***"Whoever has no rule over his own spirit is like a city broken down, without walls. (Proverbs 25:28, see Proverbs 16:32).***

How to Close Your Chakras (Gateways or Doors)

Though it is easy to open your chakras, closing them may not be easy at all. You will need the grace and strength of Yahveh to do it. Bear in mind that our God is a loving father who does not want to put heavy burdens on his children. Yahshua said, ***"Come to Me, all you who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am***

gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy and My burden is light” (Matthew 11:28-30). Another Scripture says, “No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it.” (1 Corinthians 10:13).

The Holy Spirit of Yahveh has laid down the easiest way to close these doors that have been opened to demons, and I will discuss them with you now.

The following are the steps to take when closing your chakras:

Pray to Yahveh to close your opened chakras or doorways.

Prayer, as they say, is one of the most powerful solutions to many problems. Now that the demons have been cast out, you have to pray to close your seven chakras (or gateways) so that these demons or any other evil spirit may not get access into your body again.

Pray this powerful prayer loudly:

Yod Hey Vav Hey, Yahveh, Tetragrammaton Saboath, King of kings and Lord of lords, Omnipotent, Omnipresent, Omniscient, the First and the Last, the Alpha and Omega, I call upon you to come to my aid. Please with your divine hand close again all my seven chakras that have been opened to demons. Seal them with the precious blood of Yahshua Ha Mashiach. Please assign Archangel Michael, Archangel Raphael, Archangel Gabriel, Archangel Uriel, Archangel Samael, Archangel Sachiël, and Archangel Cassiel to protect and guard each of the gateways of my body. Fill me with your righteous spirit to live a righteous life forever. In Yahshua’s name, I pray with thanksgiving. Amen.


How to Seal Your Seven Chakras

Please follow the following processes to seal your seven gateways (chakras):

1. Put your palm on the *crown* of your head, start by rubbing your palm over your *crown* while saying, *“I seal my crown chakra/gateway with the precious blood of Yahshua Ha Mashiach, and it is closed forever”*. Amen.
2. Repeat the same process with the other six chakras. Remember to *place, rub* and *pronounce* the *name* of the chakra when sealing them.

Below are the names of the seven chakras:

- 1st The Root of Sex Organs (Location: The base of the spine, in the tailbone area)
- 2nd The Sacral/Navel (Location: Just below the belly button, just above the pubic bone)
- 3rd The Solar Plexus (Location: The upper abdomen, in the stomach area)
- 4th The Heart (Location: The center of the chest)
- 5th The Throat (Location: The Throat)
- 6th The Third Eye (Location: Between the eyes, on the forehead)
- 7th The Crown (Location: The very top of head)



Conclude the process with this prayer:

“Spirit of the living God Yahveh, come upon my life and place a shield of protection around me in the name of Yahshua HaMashiach.”

Thank Yahveh and rejoice for you have *successfully* cleaned, closed, and sealed your seven doorways. You are now physically and spiritually healthy. Worship Yahveh in truth and spirit always and you shall enjoy total freedom and eternal life.

Advice:

1. Stay away from sin.
2. Stay away from any activity that can open your body doors again.
3. Read the Holy Scriptures and pray Always.

4. Take caution of the Media. What you hear or see has either a positive or negative impact on you.

CHAPTER 6

Getting Rid of Demons from Your Home/Office

Have you ever seen spirits moving in and out of your home or office? Or have you felt something like a strong shift in temperature? If so chances are you've encountered a spirit portal in your home or office.

Demons can live in persons, animals, places, toys, and other objects, and cause problems for the individual.

Portals of Demons

Whether people choose to accept it or not, our physical realm is highly related to the spiritual realm. What we do in the physical realm impacts what happens in the spiritual realm and spirits from the spiritual realm can impact us.

Just like a physical door allows you to pass from outside to inside your house (or vice versa) or a staircase allows you to travel up or down, so a portal allows being from the spiritual realm to access our physical realm.

Demonic Portals can also form in you.

If you've experienced a *particularly spiritual healing experience*, you might become an *open* portal. There are also some places, physically, that are simply more prone to connections with the spiritual realm.

Things like mirrors, windows, and doors, streets, and sidewalks can also serve as highly opened portals of demons.

Signs of Demons Presence In Your Home

When a demon or demons enter your home and your home becomes a hotbed of paranormal activity, with unexplained bangs, strange smells, and spooky visions now the norm. Sometimes, there can be regular notices of your belongings going missing mysteriously.

How to Close the Portals of Demons In Your Home/Office

Demons can have a portal to the spiritual world right in your home. That's basically, a door for the spirits to come and go through.

Once you've encountered a spirit portal (especially if it's in yourself or your home), you have several choices.

Choice #1

If the spirit portal is not connected directly to you, you can always walk away.

For example: If you have a mirror that is a portal, you can choose to give the mirror away and physically remove it from your home.

Likewise, if the house or apartment is not yours, you can also walk away.

You can opt for this kind of behavior because it's simple and easy and that's what most people do.

Choice #2

If you can't walk away from the portal you can choose to close the portal on your own.

Here are the steps to close the portals of demons:

Step #1

To close the portal, make sure that you're in a stable and healthy emotional state and place. To do so is to *burn sage to cleanse your home or office & yourself of negativity.*

Sage belongs to the *Salvia* plant family and is derived from the Latin word *salvere*, which means “to heal.” “*Aside from the metaphysical uses of smudging, research is showing that sage can also be used to benefit physical, mental, and emotional well-being,*” says Reshma Patel, PA-C, MMS, CEO and founder of Ananda Integrative Medicine.



Fresh Sage Leaf

Burning sage is also thought to ward off negativity and toxicity. You can think of it as clearing the slate for more positivity to enter your home or office.



Dry Sage Leaf

You can order the sage leaf in online stores.

While burning the dry sage leaf, say this prayer to get rid of the demons from your home or office:

Say loudly:

I cleanse this infected home (or office or other property) from all negative entities, spiritual filthiness, setbacks, bad lucks, evil spirits, familiar spirits, ancestral spirits, and demons in the name of Yahshua the Messiah. I renounce the sins that opened a door for the presence of these

demons or evil spirits in this house (or office or other property) in the name of Yahshua the Messiah. In the name of Ava Yahve h and that of his son Yahshua the Messiah, I command these demonic spirits and negative entities to live this place now and never return. May the Holy Spirit cleanse this place and fill it with his presence. May the blessing and peace of Yahveh rest on this place so that it may be a haven of rest, a home blessed by Yahveh. In Yahshua's name. Amein.

Step #2

Meditate and imagine the spirit portal being sewn up and closed.

Make sure you have commanded the spirits to leave your house before you close their portal.

Say this prayer to get rid of them from your house:

Satan, demons, evil spirits, get off my home, or office. My house or office belongs to the Almighty Yahveh from now onwards. My property, my house, my car, my office, and everything here belong to Yahveh, my Creator. Now leave. So be it.

To meditate is to make yourself very calm by relaxing completely and thinking only about one thing. Imagining is the ability to form pictures or ideas in your mind's eye.

The Bible also talks about meditation and imagination. The Bible says:

“And Isaac went out to meditate and bow down [in prayer] in the open country in the evening; and he looked up and saw that, behold, the camels were coming” (Genesis 24:53, AMP).

Kind David of Israel said:

“But his delight and desire are in the law of the LORD [YAHVEH], and on His law he habitually meditates day and night” (Psalm 1:2, AMP see Josh 1:8).

“Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart Be acceptable in Your sight, O LORD [YAHVEH], my [firm, impenetrable] Rocks and my Redeemer” (Psalm 19:14, AMP).

“When I remember You [Yahveh] upon my bed, and meditate on You in the night watches...” (Psalm 63:6, AMP).

“I will meditate on Your precepts and have respect to Your ways [the paths of life marked out by Your law]. Princes also sat and talked against me, but Your servant meditated on your statutes” (Psalm 119:14, 23, AMP).

“My eyes anticipate the night watches and I am awake before the cry of the watchman, that I may meditate on Your word” (Psalm 119:148, AMP).

“I remember the days of old; I meditate on all that You have done; I ponder the work of Your hands” (Psalm 143: 5, AMP).

Asaph the Levite of Israel said (in Psalm 77:6, 12, AMP), ***“I call to remembrance my song in the night; with my heart, I meditate and my spirit searches diligently. I will meditate also upon all Your works and consider all Your [mighty] deeds.”***

Now, start the meditation. Meditate and imagine the spirit portal being sewn up and closed.

Step #3

Say this prayer loudly and announce your intention of closing the spirit portal:

“My Father Yahveh, please close all portals that have been linking me or my family to demons by the blood of Yahshua Ha Mashiach. Through the blood of Yahshua Ha Mashiach, I ask all portals to be closed and sealed. I am now free. Amein.”

You're done.

CHAPTER 7

The 5 Proven Ways to Protect Yourself from the Attacks of Demons

Demons are spiritual entities and angels that were cast out of heaven after following their leader, Satan, in rebellion against Yahveh. Because of their transgressions, they now roam the earth as they await the final judgment.

But what if you have nothing to be afraid of? What if you could easily protect yourself from their attacks and manipulations?

I am here to show you how you can protect yourself from these demonic spirits.

For some, what I am about to show you will feel familiar. There is no magic bullet here and no mystical incantation that will safeguard you for all time.

Protecting yourself against demonic attacks and manipulations takes work, perseverance, and a life devoted to Yahshua the Messiah.

Are you ready for that?

If you are, protection is at your fingertips. I have laid down the most effective things you can do to protect yourself from demonic attacks and manipulations.

Let's take a look at the 5 proven ways to protect yourself from the attacks and manipulations of Demons:

Proven Way #1: Living A Righteous Life

The basis of protecting yourself from the attacks and manipulations of demons begins with making the right choice. And that right choice is to live a righteous life.

What is righteousness? Righteousness is obedience to the laws of Yahveh. The Bible says, *“And if we are careful to obey all this law before the LORD our God, as he has commanded us, that will be our righteousness”* (Deuteronomy 6:25, NIV).

In simple terms, living a righteous life means staying away from intentional sins. What is sin? Sin is the transgression of the law of Yahveh. The Bible says, *“Everyone who sins breaks the*

law; in fact, sin is lawlessness” (1 John 3:4, NIV). The Amplified Version says more: “Everyone who practices sin also practices lawlessness; and sin is lawlessness [ignoring God’s law by action or neglect or by tolerating wrongdoing—being unrestrained by His commands and His will]” (1 John 3:4, AMP).

The only way to live a sinless life is to strictly obey the Ten Major Laws of Yahveh which according to Exodus 20: 1- 17 says:

Law #1

You shall have no other gods before me.

Law #2

You shall not bow down to idols or worship them.

Law #3

You shall not misuse the name of the LORD [Yahveh] your God.

Law #4

Remember the Sabbath day [Saturday Worship] by keeping it holy.

Law #5

Honor your father and your mother [elderly people].

Law #6

You shall not murder.

Law #7

You shall not commit adultery.

Law #8

You shall not steal.

Law #9

You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.

Law #10

You shall not covet your neighbor’s house. You shall not covet your neighbor’s wife, or his male or female servant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.

If you keep the above laws exactly and passionately, you'll be sinless and it will fend off demons. In this way, you'll cultivate the Fruits of the Spirit which will lead you to a good spiritual life. Only then, you can be born of Yahveh. The Bible says, "***Whoever has been born of God [Yahveh] does not sin, for His seed remains in him; and he cannot sin, because he has been born of God [Yahveh]***" The more you're centered on Yahveh, and the more you have a spiritual life, the stronger we'll be.

If you remain in sin, you are more easily attacked, influenced, and manipulated by demons. Know that these demons want nothing more than to *separate* you as much as they can from the light and love of Yahveh. Therefore, protect yourself from demonic attacks and manipulations by consistently living a righteous life.

Remember that in the exercise of your free will you are the author of your own destiny. Demons can only influence, attack, and manipulate you to the *extent* that you let them.

Proven Way #2: Join a Good, Spirit-Filled Assembly

Joining a good, spirit-filled assembly will help you grow spiritually over time, and give you the support you need to make and maintain good choices.

A Spirit-filled assembly teaches, instructs, inspires, and corrects. Without it, you risk straying from a spiritual life based upon the Word of Yahveh to a spiritual life instructed by the self.

Therein lies vulnerability to demonic attack.

Why Join A Good, Spirit-Filled Assembly

Many people today think, "Why should they join an assembly?" What is the point of joining? Moreover, many believers have been burned by a church (*appropriate word: assembly or congregation*). They got involved in serving, only to have someone attack them or spread false rumors about them. Some were also involved in a congregation where they trusted the pastor, only to find out that the pastor was having an affair with some assembly members and that resulted in a lot of unpleasant conflict in the congregation. To avoid that kind of painful situation, many people don't want to commit to any congregation. They have a personal relationship with the son of God but they are distrustful of getting too involved with the assembly.

Let me tell you this. To be an obedient believer and to protect yourself from the attacks and manipulations of demons, you must go beyond assembly attendance to being committed, serving

member of a local congregation. A person who professes the Messiah but feels no desire to be among his believing brothers and sisters is not a *healthy* believer.

John Stott said in his book, *The Message of Ephesians: God's New Society* [IVP], p.129, *"If the church is central to God's purpose, as seen in both history and the gospel, it must surely also be central to our lives. How can we take lightly what God takes so seriously? How dare we push to the circumference what God has placed at the center?"*

The centrality of the assembly to Yahveh's purpose should be reason enough for you to be committed to an assembly.

The assembly or congregation helps you to spiritually grow over time and gives you the support you need to maintain a righteous life.

The assembly as a collective whole teaches, instructs, inspires, and corrects. Without it, you risk straying from a spiritual life based upon the Word of Yahveh to a spiritual life instructed by the self. In this lies vulnerability to demonic attack, influence, and manipulation.

These are other reasons why you should join an assembly:

I. Yahshua loves the assembly and gave himself for it

If you love Yahshua the Messiah, you should love his assembly and commit yourself to its well-being. The Bible says, ***"Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ [the Messiah] also loved the church [assembly], and gave himself for it"*** (Ephesians 5:25, KJV). A believer in the Assembly of God. Remember that Yahshua has married you — the assembly (church).

The following Scriptures explain it all:

"For thy Maker is thine husband; the LORD of hosts is his name; and thy Redeemer the Holy One of Israel; The God of the whole earth shall he be called" (Isaiah 54:5, KJV).

For I am jealous for you with a godly jealousy. I promised you to one husband, Christ [the Messiah] so that I might present you as a pure virgin to him" (2 Corinthians 11:2, NIV).

"For this, cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh. This is a great mystery: but I speak concerning Christ [the Messiah] and the church" (Ephesians 5:31, 32, KJV, see also Revelation 19:7-9; 21:2).

So joining the assembly is one of your obligations as a wife to Yahshua, your husband. The Bible says, ***"First they gave themselves to the Lord; and then, by God's will they gave themselves to us as well"*** (2 Corinthians 8:5b GNT).

Yahveh has given everyone at least one spiritual gift to help build up Yahshua's Assembly (cross-reference: Romans 12:3-8; 1 Corinthians 12:4-11; 1 Peter 4:10-11). If Yahshua loved his assembly enough to die for her, then each and everyone who loves Yahshua the Messiah should love his assembly and be committed to her well-being.

II. You learn practically to love God and others

To love someone is to be committed to the person. You need a strong enough commitment to help you work through personal conflicts and difficulties that inevitably arise in the assembly so that you grow in love for one another.

Commitment is the glue that holds relationships together and enables you to grow in love when there are conflicts. That's why living together outside of a committed marriage relationship is bound to fail — there's no lasting commitment. If you casually date the assembly or even if you move in and live together with an assembly for a while without the commitment of membership, you will bail out as soon as you encounter difficulties, as you surely will.

Steven J. Cole said, *“Take the other analogy that the church [assembly] is the body of Christ [Yahshua]. What would happen if your hand decided, “I don't like being joined to this arm”? “It's too restrictive! When the arm says that we're going somewhere, I don't have any choice in the matter. I've got to go along. I'm going to cut myself off from this stupid arm so that I can have a little independence in life!” We all know that our hand would be absolutely useless if it were cut off from our arm!”*

If you are not committed to other believers, you won't be able to serve Yahveh effectively. You won't be able to learn to grow in love for others. The Bible says, ***“If a man says, I love God, and hateth his brother, he is a liar: for he that loveth not his brother whom he hath seen, how can he love God whom he hath not seen? And this commandment has we from him, that he who loveth God love his brother also” (1 John 4:20, 21, KJV).*** Being committed to an assembly is where you learn practically to love Yahveh and others.

III. To place yourself under spiritual shepherds

You need to place yourself under spiritual shepherds who will care for you and give an account for your soul.

Jonathan Leeman (*Church Membership [Crossway], pp. 25-30*) argues that *“We need a paradigm shift regarding the local church [assembly]. It isn't a club or voluntary organization where membership is optional if the club provides what you're looking for. It's not a group of people who like to get together and talk about religious ideas. It's not “a service provided, where the customer has all authority. Because Jesus [Yahshua] is the Sovereign King over His church [assembly], “Christians [believers] don't join churches [assemblies]; they submit to them.”*

Hebrews 13:17, KJV states, ***“Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not***

*with grief: for that is unprofitable for you.” This doesn’t mean that individual believers are absolved from being responsible to grow in holiness. And it doesn’t also mean blind submission to leaders who may violate or ignore Scripture by lording it over the flock. The Bible says, **“Feed the flock of God which is among you, taking the oversight thereof, not by constraint, but willingly; not for filthy lucre, but of a ready mind. Neither as being lords over God’s heritage, but being ensamples to the flock”** (1 Peter 5:2, 3, KJV).*

What this Scripture means is submitting to the shepherds of the assembly, assuming that you all are seeking to obey Yahveh’s word. The Apostle Paul told the Thessalonian assembly: **“And we beseech you, brethren, to know them which labour among you, and are over you in the Lord, and admonish you. And to esteem them very highly in love for their work’s sake. And be at peace among yourselves”** (1 Thessalonians 5:12, 13, KJV).

IV. To fulfill the Great Commission

The assembly is Yahshua’s ordained means of fulfilling his Great Commission, to make disciples of all nations. The assembly’s job is to be committed to planting local assemblies and training leaders to preach the Word and to make disciples. Paul also said that to the assembly in Philippians: **“Only let your conversation be as it becometh the gospel of Christ [the Messiah]: that whether I come and see you, or else be absent, I may hear of your affairs, that ye stand fast in one spirit, with one mind striving together for the faith of the gospel”** (Philippians 1:27, KJV).

The gospel of Yahshua can best be spread through combined and collaborative efforts. Throughout the history of the assembly, great men and women have attempted great things on their own and have often been successful. But more often, great things have been accomplished through the collaborative efforts of believers working together as one body (assembly). If we are to reach this world with the gospel message of Yahshua the Messiah, we must share our efforts with other believers.

V. To have a specific place to serve your Creator

Yahveh has given you a spiritual gift, which you are to use in serving him. The Bible says, **“As every man hath received the gift, even so, minister the same one to another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God”** (1 Peter 4:10, KJV). Stewardship means that each believer will give an account to the Master who entrusted the stewardship to him or her. In the parable of the talents (Matthew 25:14-30), it was the servant who was given only one talent (a sum of money) who buried it and gave it back to the master without any gain. The master rebuked him most harshly. The danger for the one-talent person is, if you think, “I can’t do much for the Lord because I’m not an evangelist or pastor,” you’ll bury your talent. You need to figure out how Yahveh wants you to serve and do it for him in a particular assembly where you are committed.

Yahveh, the God of Israel is honored when we are obedient to him. He is glorified when his children come together in unity and harmony to find assurance, to propagate his Word to the world, to expose false gospels, and to edify one another. God is glorified in and through the local assembly.

It is good to join a good, Spirit-filled assembly if you haven't or are not in a spirit-filled assembly that is to say a true theocratic assembly. The Bible says, ***“Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is; but exhorting one another: and so much the more, as ye see the Day approaching” (Hebrews 10:25, KJV)***. Bear in mind that not all churches or congregations are from Yahveh. These days more and more churches are being established by agents of Satan and Demons themselves. So beware!

What is a Spirit-filled Assembly?

A Spirit-filled assembly is a true theocratic assembly of Yahveh in the Messiah Yahshua popularly referred to as “Messianic Judaism”. It is characterized by the obeying of Yahveh’s Ten Commandments and the Testimony or Faith of Yahshua the Messiah. The Law of Yahveh keeps us from intentionally sinning against our Creator and mankind. The testimony and faith of Yahshua the Messiah grant us grace to live eternally. Any assembly or congregation that follows these two divine principles (the keeping of the Ten Commandments with more emphasis on the 7th Day Sabbath [Saturday] and the testimony or the faith of our Lord Yahshua the Messiah) is a true spirit-filled assembly. The Holy Scriptures confirm it:

Romans 7:12 says,

“Wherefore the law is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good.”

Romans 7:14 says,

“For we know that the law is spiritual...”

Romans 3:31 says,

“Do we then make void the law through faith? God forbid: yea, we establish the law.”

Revelation 12:17 says,

“And the dragon was wrath with the woman, and went to make war with the remnant of her seed, which keeps the commandments of God, and have the testimony of Jesus Christ [Yahshua the Messiah].”

Revelation 14:12 says,

“Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus.”

Revelation 19:10 says,

“And I fell at his feet to worship him. And he said unto me, See thou do it not: I am thy fellow servant, and of thy brethren that have the testimony of Jesus [Yahshua]: worship God: for the testimony of Jesus [Yahshua the Messiah] is the spirit of prophecy.”

Isaiah prophesied saying,

“To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them” (Isaiah 8:20, KJV).

Signs of a Spirit-filled Assembly

I. Yahshua Centered

A good, Spirit-filled Assembly is the assembly that emphasizes the work of the Holy Spirit in the New Covenant to build up the assembly into the likeness of the Messiah. The Bible says, **“For even hereunto were ye called: because Christ [the Messiah] also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that ye should follow his steps” (1 Peter 2:21, KJV)**. Another Scriptures says, **“Keep watch over yourselves and all the flock of which the Holy Spirit has made you overseers. Be shepherds of the church [appropriate word: the assembly or congregation] of God, which he bought with his own blood” (Acts 20:28, NIV)**. A Spirit-filled assembly imitates the values and character of Yahshua himself. The Bible says, **“Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus [the Messiah Yahshua]” (Philippians 2:1-5, KJV)**. Another Scripture says, **“For other foundation can no man lay than that is laid, which is Jesus Christ [Yahshua the Messiah]” (1 Corinthians 3:11, KJV)**.

II. One Accord (Unity)

The body of Yahshua cannot be built with divided minds or people. An important aspect of this *building-up* work of the Holy Spirit is to *join* diverse people into a single body united in and around Yahshua and the central tenets of the true gospel (read Ephesians 2:19-22; 4:3,12). The Father (Yahveh) and the Son (Yahshua) are one in mind, will, and purpose and so should the assemblies of God. Yahshua the Messiah desires unity and love among believers. Ellen G. White wrote, *“Believers should make every effort to avoid tendencies (habits) that would divide them and bring dishonor to their cause. It is the purpose of God that His children shall blend in unity. Do they not expect to live together in the same heaven?... Those who refuse to work in harmony greatly dishonor God” (Testimonies for the Church)*. A Spirit-filled Assembly is the One Body of Yahshua (read 1 Corinthians 12:12-31 and Romans 12:4-21).

III. Purification

A true, Spirit-filled assembly is shaped into conformity to Yahshua the Messiah, who leads them to purge their lives of remaining sin and bear the fruit of righteousness. The Bible says, **“For if ye live after the flesh, ye shall die: but if ye through the Spirit do mortify the deeds of the body, ye shall live. For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God” (Romans 8:13, 14, KJV)**. Another Scripture says, **“This I say then, walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh” (Galatians 5:16, KJV)**. Thus, a true Spirit-filled assembly will not reflect the principles of a secular society but exhibit God-centered righteousness.

IV. Doctrinal Truthfulness

A good, Spirit-filled assembly is associated with the unadulterated truth as written in the Holy Scriptures, revealed by the Holy Spirit, and sealed with the precious blood of Yahshua. The Holy Spirit leads believers into all truth, enabling us to understand and discern what is true, and therefore hold fast to God’s revealed truth in Scripture without compromise. The following Holy Scriptures says it all:

“But we belong to God. Whoever knows God, listens to us; whoever does not belong to God does not listen to us. This then is how we can tell the difference between the spirit of truth and the spirit of error” (1 John 4:6 GNT).

“But he, the Spirit of truth, comes; he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come. He will bring glory to me by taking from what is mine and making it known to you” (John 16: 13-14, NIV).

“That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ [Yahshua the Messiah], the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him” (Ephesians 1:17, KJV).

“Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God; that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God” (1 Corinthians 2:12, KJV).

So join and connect with a good, Spirit-filled assembly in your area because you will need to get plugged into good teaching and good fellowship with other believers, like the Bible, has told us not to forsake the assembling of ourselves together with one another (Hebrews 10:25, KJV).

V. Spiritual Empowerment and Improvement

A good, Spirit-filled assembly is filled with empowerment for boldly sharing the good news of salvation in Yahshua. The Bible says, ***“But ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost [appropriate word: Holy Spirit] is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth” (Acts 1:8, KJV)***. The Holy Spirit also empowers believers with diverse spiritual gifts for building up the assembly as a whole. The Bible says, ***“And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost [Holy Spirit], and they spoke the word of God with boldness” (Acts 4:31, KJV, see also 1 Corinthians 12:7-11)***.

Mount Olivet Messianic Judaism is a Spirit-filled Assembly

If you cannot find any church or congregation around you that has the signs of a good, Spirit-filled assembly, then you can join my assembly. This is because; Mount Olivet Messianic Judaism has passed an honest assessment which shows that there are clear signs of the spirit of God wonderfully at work in the assembly. We are not just relaxing because we are a spirit-filled assembly; we are still working hard for a continual filling by the Holy Spirit to work powerfully in our midst that we might be to a greater extent a Spirit-filled assembly. The Bible says, ***“And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit” (Ephesians 5:18, KJV)***.

Don't just be an assembly attendee, become a committed member.

The Difference Between An Assembly Attendee And A Member

The key difference between an assembly (inappropriate word: church) attendee and an assembly (church) member is *“commitment”*. There are three differences between an assembly attendee and a member. They are:

1. An assembly (church) attendee is a spectator from the sidelines but a member gets *involved* in the assembly.
2. An assembly (church) attendee is a consumer while a member is a contributor.
3. An assembly (church) attendee wants to benefit from the assembly without sharing the responsibility, but a member wants the assembly to benefit from him or her as he or she also benefits from the assembly. The Bible says, ***“Anyone who receives instructions in the word must share all good things with his instructor” (Galatians 6:6, NIV)***.

You should be a committed assembly member to protect yourself from the attacks and the influence of demons. The Bible says, ***“They committed themselves to the teaching of the apostles, the life together, the common meal, and the prayers” (Acts 2:42, MSG)***.

Proven Way #3: Study the Word of Yahveh

Studying the word of Yahveh will help you develop a close, personal relationship with your Creator. Studying the word of Yahveh can change your perspectives, attitudes, and heal and restore your soul.

The Bible, Yahveh's Word, is our instruction manual, or our road map, for life. It contains wisdom, encouragement, comfort, and life-changing power. And if there isn't a specific answer to a particular situation or problem, you'll find life principles that lead you to it.

The word of Yahveh is a powerful weapon that can destroy your enemies totally. The Bible says, ***“For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart” (Hebrews 4:12).***

In Matthew chapter 4, we found that Yahshua Ha Mashiach defeated the Devil with the word of Yahveh when he was tempted by the Devil.

Studying the word of Yahveh always is one of the proven ways to protect your body and soul from the attacks and manipulations of Satan and demons.

Remember, knowledge is power. Therefore, when you equip yourself with the knowledge of your creator, Satan and demons fear to come closer to you. Because they know they can be destroyed by it. The more you study the word of Yahveh, the more your spiritual life grows to maturity. The Devil will not dare to confront you.

Yahveh loves you unconditionally, and He wants to help you. He wants you to be whole in Yahshua and enjoy the great life He's planned for you. In His Word, you will find everything you need to discover restoration and wholeness and to be the person you were created to be. The key is studying the Bible and doing it consistently so you can continually grow in your relationship with Yahveh one day at a time.

The Bible says, ***“Heaven and earth will pass away, but My words will by no means pass away” (Matthew 24:35).*** This scripture shows how powerful the word of Yahveh is.

Here are some benefits of studying the word of Yahveh:

1. The word of Yahveh gives you direction. The Bible says, *“Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path” (Psalm 109:105).*
2. The word of Yahveh is the answer to all prayers. The Bible says, *“If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, you will ask what you desire, and it shall be done for you” (John 15:7).*
3. The word of Yahveh nourishes you to grow. The Bible says, *“But He answered and said, “It is written, ‘Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God” (Matthew 4:4).*

4. The word of Yahveh helps to resist temptation. *The Bible says, “Your word I have hidden in my heart, that I might not sin against You” (Psalm 119:11).*
5. The word of Yahveh gives you freedom. The Bible says, *“Then Yahshua said to those Jews who believed Him, “If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed. And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free” (John 8:31-32).*
6. The Word of Yahveh becomes your weapon as you stand in the face of life’s challenges and struggles. The Bible says, *“And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God” (Ephesians 6:17).*

Proven Way #4: Pray Always

Fr. Fortea says that *“When tempted, prayer is our greatest weapon, a weapon as powerful as the greatest army or wealth. The demons know the power of prayer and fear it.”*

Prayer, as a direct connection between you and Yahveh, is one of the most effective and easily accessed defenses against the Devil’s power. Fr. Fortea tells us that *“it doesn’t matter whether prayer is spoken aloud or merely mental—it’s still just as powerful.”*

It’s a good idea to cultivate a habit of daily prayer, but you can employ this spiritual tool whenever you feel an unusual temptation to make an immoral choice. Ask Yahveh to protect you, and to use His power or send His angels to banish any evil that may have attached itself to you.

Prayer is a two-edged sword. One edge has the power to construct (create) and the other has the power to destroy. Therefore, prayer is a great weapon of construction and destruction.

Prayer is talking to Yahveh and having him talk to us. It is spending time in communion with our heavenly father.

One day the five-year-old son of D.L. Moody went into the study room where his father sat writing. Wanting no interruption, Mr. Moody gruffly (sounding unfriendly or annoyed) asked, “Well, what do you want?” “Nothing, Daddy,” the boy replied. “I just wanted to be where you are.” Sitting on the floor, he began to amuse himself quietly. He desired only companionship.

To pray is to be where your creator is. When you are in his presence, you need nothing more to pray prevailingly.

Prayer is also communion. Communion is a feeling of sharing thoughts and emotions with someone. There are two ways to communion with your creator, Yahveh. They are:

1. Meditation/Imagination

Meditation is making yourself very calm by relaxing completely and thinking only about one thing.

Imagination is the ability to form pictures or ideas in your mind's eye.

The Bible also teaches us to meditate on who Yahveh is, what he has done, and what he has said.

The Bible says, *“Isaac went out to meditate and bow down [in prayer] in the field in the [early] evening; he raised his eyes and looked, and camels were coming” (Genesis 24:63AMP).*

The Bible says,

“This book of the law shall not depart out of thy mouth; but thou shalt meditate therein day and night, that thou mayest observe to do according to all that is written therein: for then thou shalt make thy way prosperous, and then thou shalt have good success” (Joshua 1:8, KJV).

“But his delight and desire are in the law of the Lord, and on His law, he habitually meditates by day and by night” (Psalm 1:2 AMP).

King David said:

“When I remember you upon my bed and meditate on you in the night watches...” (Psalm 63:6 AMP).

“My eyes anticipate the night watches and I am awake before the cry of the watchman, that I may meditate on your word” (Psalm 119:148 AMP).

“I will meditate on your precepts and have respect to your ways [the paths of life marked out by your law]. Princes also sat and talked against me, but your servant meditated on your statutes” (Psalm 119:15, 23 AMP).

“I call to remembrance my song on the night; with my heart, I meditate and my spirit searches diligently. I will meditate also upon all your works and consider all your mighty deeds” (Psalm 77:6, 12 AMP).

“Let the words of my mouth and the meditation of my heart be acceptable in your sight, O Yahveh, my [firm, impenetrable] Rock and my Redeemer” (Psalm 19:14 AMP).

“I remember the days of old; I meditate on all thy works; I muse on the work of thy hands” (Psalm 143:5, KJV).

It is not possible to be Yahveh's friend aside from knowing what he says. You can't love Yahveh unless you know him, and you can't know him without knowing his word.

Though you cannot spend all the day studying Yahveh's Word, you can *think* about it throughout the day, recalling Bible verses you have read or memorized and pondering over them in your

mind. Start growing in the knowledge of God and all of His ways by reading and studying the Bible regularly. The more of Yahveh's Word you can get in you, the freer and stronger you will become in Yahveh over time.

"Some people presume meditation is a difficult and mysterious ritual practiced by some isolated monks and mystics. But the truth is that meditation is simply focused thinking — a skill anyone can learn and use anywhere" (Pastor Rich Warren).

When you think about a problem over and over in your mind, it is called worry. In the same way, when you think about Yahveh's Word over and over in your mind, that's called meditation.

Friends share secrets, and Yahveh will share his secrets with you if you develop the habit of thinking about his word throughout the day.

The more time you spend meditating upon the word of Yahveh, the more you will understand the secrets of this life that most people don't. The Bible says, ***"Friendship with God is reserved for those who reverence him. With them alone, he shares the secrets of his promises" (Psalm 25:14 LB).***

Don't waste time anymore, start today by practicing constant conversation with Yahveh and continual meditation on his Word. Pray and meditate always, because prayer lets you speak to Yahveh, and meditation lets Yahveh speak to you. Note that both are necessary for becoming a friend of Yahveh.

2. Thought /Thinking

Thought is something that you think of, for example, an idea or opinion. The Bible says, ***"You know everything I do; from far away you understand all my thoughts. You see me, whether I am working or resting; you know all my actions. Even before I speak, you already know what I will say" (Psalm 139:2-4, GNT).***

You create your entire world by the way you think. The Bible says, ***"Be careful how you think; your life is shaped by your thoughts" (Proverbs 4:23, GNT).***

Your thoughts are the primary creative forces in your life. All the people and situations in your life have only the meaning you give them by the way you think about them.

And when you change your thinking, you change your life, sometimes in seconds!

The most important principle of your personal life or business success is simply this: You become what you think about most of the time. Therefore, thought becomes prayer. The Bible says, ***"I know their thoughts and their deeds" (Isaiah 66:18a, GNT).***

This is the great discovery upon, which all religions, philosophies, metaphysics, schools of thought, and psychology are based.

Whatever you see or experience is the expression of the thinking of the people behind the phenomenon. It is not what happens to you but how you think about what happens to you that determines how you feel and react.

It is not the world outside of you that dictates your circumstances or conditions. It is the world inside you that creates the conditions of your life. The Bible says, ***“As for you, Solomon my son, know the God of your father [have personal knowledge of Him, be acquainted with, and understand Him; appreciate, heed, and cherish Him] and serve Him with a blameless heart and a willing mind; for the Lord searches all hearts and minds, and understands every intent and inclination of the thoughts. If you seek Him [inquiring for and of Him and requiring Him as your first and vital necessity] He will let you find Him; but [a]if you abandon (turn away from) Him, He will reject you forever” (1 Chronicles 28:9, AMP).***

Our father Yahveh has given all of us a choice (read Deuteronomy 11:26-28; 30:15). You’re always free to choose. In the long run, no one forces you to think, feel or behave the way you do. Rather, you choose your emotions and your behaviors by the way you choose to think about the world around you and how you choose to think about what is happening to you.

Your choice is the critical determinant of everything you are and everything you become. Thought is creative. The Bible says, ***“The thoughts of the diligent tend only to plenteousness; but of everyone that is hasty only to want” (Proverbs 21:5, KJV).***

Your thoughts and feelings are continually changing. They are quickly affected by the events around you. For example, when you receive a piece of good news, your attitude immediately brightens and you feel more positive toward everyone and everything. If on the other hand, you unexpectedly receive some bad news, you can immediately become upset, angry, and short-tempered, even if the news is inaccurate or untrue.

It is the way you interpret the event to yourself that determines how you react. ***“My friends, fill your minds with those things that are good and that deserve praise: things that are true, noble, right, pure, lovely, and honorable. Put into practice what you learned and received from me, both from my words and from my actions. And the God who gives us peace will be with you” (Philippians 4:8-9, GNT).***

Connecting Prayer to the Weapons of the Saints.

Though prayer is not associated with any material thing when the Bible made mention of the armor of the saints, it doesn’t make it a standalone weapon. It is linked to all the armor of the saints. Prayer among the weapons of the saints is like a grain of salt in a soup. Without salt, the soup will become tasteless. In the same way, without prayer, the other weapons will become unfunctional.

However, prayer alone cannot make all the saints’ weapons become functional. It needs to be combined with the Law of God. The wisest man Solomon said, ***“He that turneth away his ear from hearing the law, even his prayer shall be abomination (Proverbs 28:9).*** So prayer without

the keeping of the Sabbath (Saturday) and the other Nine Commandments is an abomination to your Creator. Prayer becomes ineffective without the Law of God.

How Powerful is Prayer?

In six ways, I will tell you how powerful prayer is. Many believers I had an encounter with have experienced what I am about to share with you likewise myself. If you are a dedicated prayerful woman or man, I know you have also experience either all or some of what I am about to share with you. Here are the six ways that prove that prayer is a powerful weapon to believers.

Prayer has:

1. The power to heal:

Don't underestimate the power of prayer. The Bible says, *"The weapons we use in our fight are not the world's weapons but God's powerful weapons, which we use to destroy strongholds. We destroy false arguments; we pull down every proud obstacle that is raised against the knowledge of God; we take every thought captive and make it obey Christ [the Messiah]"* (2 Corinthians 10:4, 5).

Prayer has the power to heal and really heals. The Bible says, *"So then, confess your sins to one another and pray for one another, so that you will be healed. The prayer of a good person has a powerful effect. Elijah was the same kind of person as we are. He prayed earnestly that there would be no rain, and no rain fell on the land for three and a half years. Once again he prayed and the sky poured out its rain and the earth produced its crops"* (James 5: 16-18 GNT). The Bible again says, *"When they came to the crowd, a man approached Jesus [Yahshua] and knelt before him Lord, have mercy on my son, he said. He has seizures and is suffering greatly. He often falls into the fire or into the water. I brought him to your disciples, but they could not heal him. O unbelieving and perverse generation, Jesus [Yahshua] replied, how long shall I stay with you? How long shall I put up with you? Bring the boy here to me. Jesus [Yahshua] rebuked the demon, and it came out of the boy, and he was healed from that moment. Then the disciples came to Jesus [Yahshua] in private and asked, why couldn't we drive it out? He replied because you have so little faith. I tell you the truth, if you have faith as small as a mustard seed, you can say to this mountain, move from here to there and it will move. Nothing will be impossible for you. But this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting"* (Matthew 17:14-21, NIV).

2. The power to overcome enemies

By prayer, we win the battle over our enemies. Our enemies are defeated through prayer. The Bible says, *"Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of*

the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand” (Ephesians 6:11-13).

3. The power to conquer death

By prayer, the dead son of the Shunammite woman was raised to life. The Bible says, *“And when Elisha was come into the house, behold, the child was dead, and laid upon his bed. He went in, therefore, and shut the door upon them twain, and prayed unto the LORD. And he went up, and lay upon the child, and put his mouth upon his mouth, and his eyes upon his eyes, and his hands upon his hands: and he stretched himself upon the child; and the flesh of the child waxed warm. Then he returned, and walked in the house to and fro; and went up, and stretched himself upon him: and the child sneezed seven times, and the child opened his eye” (2 Kings 4:32-35).*

Lazarus was raised from the dead to live by the power of prayer. The Bible says, *“Jesus [Yahshua] therefore again groaning in himself cometh to the grave. It was a cave, and a stone lay upon it. Jesus [Yahshua] said, Take ye away the stone. Martha, the sister of him that was dead, saith unto him, Lord, by this time he stinketh: for he hath been dead four days. Jesus [Yahshua] saith unto her, said I not unto thee, that, if thou wouldest believe, thou shouldest see the glory of God? Then they took away the stone from the place where the dead was laid. And Jesus [Yahshua] lifted up his eyes, and said, Father, I thank thee that thou hast heard me. And I knew that thou hearest me always: but because of the people which stand by I said it, that they may believe that thou hast sent me. And when he thus had spoken, he cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth. And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with grave clothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus [Yahshua] saith unto them, loose him, and let him go (John 11:38-44).*

Tabitha who was also known as Dorcas was raised from the dead by the power of prayer. The Bible says, *“Now there was at Joppa a certain disciple named Tabitha, which by interpretation is called Dorcas: this woman was full of good works and almsdeeds which she did. And it came to pass in those days, that she was sick, and died: whom when they had washed, they laid her in an upper chamber. And forasmuch as Lydda was nigh to Joppa, and the disciples had heard that Peter was there, they sent unto him two men, desiring him that he would not delay to come to them. Then Peter arose and went with them. When he was come, they brought him into the upper chamber: and all the widows stood by him weeping, and shewing the coats and garments which Dorcas made, while she was with them. But Peter put them all forth, and kneeled down, and prayed; and turning him to the body said, Tabitha, arise. And she opened her eyes: and when she saw Peter, she sat up. And he gave her his hand, and lifted her up, and when he had called the saints and widows, presented her alive” (Acts 9:36-41).*

A young man Eutychus was brought back to life from the dead. The Bible says, *“And there sat in a window a certain young man named Eutychus, being fallen into a deep sleep: and as Paul*

was long preaching, he sunk down with sleep, and fell down from the third loft, and was taken up dead. And Paul went down, and fell on him, and embracing him said, trouble not yourselves; for his life is in him. When he therefore was come up again, and had broken bread, and eaten, and talked a long while, even till break of day, so he departed. And they brought the young man alive, and were not a little comforted” (Acts 20:9-12).

4. The power to set the physically challenge free

The blind, the lame, the dumb, the deaf, the hunchback, and leprosy can be set free by prayer. The Bible says, *“And he entered again into the synagogue; and there was a man there which had a withered hand. And they watched him, whether he would heal him on the Sabbath day; that they might accuse him. And he saith unto the man which had the withered hand, stand forth. And when he had looked round about on them with anger, being grieved for the hardness of their hearts, he saith unto the man, stretch forth thine hand. And he stretched it out: and his hand was restored whole as the other” (Mark 3:1-3, 5).*

The following scripture quotations will tell you more about the power of prayer in setting the deformed free:

“And, behold, there came a leper and worshipped him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean. And Jesus [Yahshua] put forth his hand, and touched him, saying, I will; be thou clean. And immediately his leprosy was cleansed” (Matthew 8:2, 3).

“And when Jesus [Yahshua] departed thence, two blind men followed him, crying, and saying, thou Son of David, have mercy on us. And when he was come into the house, the blind men came to him: and Jesus [Yahshua] saith unto them, believe ye that I am able to do this? They said unto him, yea, Lord. Then touched he their eyes, saying, According to your faith be it unto you. And their eyes were opened; and Jesus [Yahshua] strictly charged them, saying, see that no man know it” (Matthew 9:27-30).

“As they went out, behold, they brought to him a dumb man possessed with a devil. And when the devil was cast out, the dumb spake: and the multitudes marveled, saying, It was never so seen in Israel” (Matthew 9:32, 33).

5. The power to cast out demons

It takes prayer to cast out demons. The Bible says, *“When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with [his] word, and healed all that were sick” (Matthew 8:16).* Another Scripture says, *“And when he was come to the other side into the country of the Gergesenes, there met him two possessed with devils, coming out of the tombs, exceeding fierce, so that no man might pass by that way. And,*

behold, they cried out, saying, what have we to do with thee, Jesus [Yahshua], thou Son of God? Art thou come hither to torment us before the time? And there was a good way off from them a herd of many swine feeding. So the devils besought him, saying, if thou cast us out, suffer us to go away into the herd of swine. And he said unto them, Go. And when they were come out, they went into the herd of swine: and, behold, the whole herd of swine ran violently down a steep place into the sea, and perished in the waters” (Matthew 8:28-32).

A dump spirit was cast out by prayer. The Bible says, *“When Jesus [Yahshua] saw that the people came running together, he rebuked the foul spirit, saying unto him, thou dumb and deaf spirit, I charge thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him. And the spirit cried, and rent him sore, and came out of him: and he was as one dead; insomuch that many said, He is dead. But Jesus [Yahshua] took him by the hand, and lifted him up; and he arose. And when he was come into the house, his disciples asked him privately, why could not we cast him out? And he said unto them, this kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting” (Mark 9:25-29).*

6. The power to open eyes, change hearts, grant wisdom and heal all wounds

The extends of the power of prayer cannot be underestimated. It has no bounds. The power of prayer opens both physical and spiritual eyes. The Bible says, *“And he cometh to Bethsaida; and they bring a blind man unto him, and besought him to touch him. And he took the blind man by the hand, and led him out of the town; and when he had spit on his eyes, and put his hands upon him, he asked him if he saw ought. And he looked up, and said, I see men as trees, walking. After that he put his hands again upon his eyes, and made him look up: and he was restored, and saw every man clearly” (Mark 8:22-25).* The Bible again says, *“The blind receive their sight, and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and the poor have the gospel preached to them” (Matthew 11:5).*

It changes stubborn and/or iron hearts. The Bible says, *“And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint. Saying, There was in a city a judge, which feared not God, neither regarded man. And there was a widow in that city; and she came unto him, saying, Avenge me of mine adversary. And he would not for a while: but afterward he said within himself, though I fear not God, nor regard man. Yet because this widow troubleth me, I will avenge her, lest by her continual coming she weary me. And the Lord said, Hear what the unjust judge saith. And shall not God avenge his own elect, which cry day and night unto him, though he bear long with them? I tell you that he will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless when the Son of man cometh, shall he find faith on the earth?” (Luke 18:1-8).*

The power of prayer grants wisdom to the foolish. The Bible says, *“If any of you lack wisdom, let him ask of God, that giveth to all men liberally, and upbraideth not; and it shall be given him” (James 1:5).*

Prayer heals all inner and outer wounds and hurts. The Bible says, **“See now that I, even I, am he, and there is no god with me: I kill, and I make alive; I wound, and I heal: neither is there any that can deliver out of my hand” (Deuteronomy 32:39).**

What the Holy Scriptures say concerning prayer:

“Thou shalt make thy prayer unto him, and he shall hear thee, and thou shalt pay thy vows” (Job 22:27).

“My voice shalt thou hear in the morning, O LORD; in the morning will I direct my prayer unto thee, and will look up” (Psalms 5:3).

“But as for me, when they were sick, my clothing was sackcloth: I humbled my soul with fasting; and my prayer returned into mine own bosom” (Psalms 35:13).

“O thou that hearest prayer, unto thee shall all flesh come” (Psalms 65:2).

“He will regard the prayer of the destitute, and not despise their prayer” (Psalms 102:17).

“For my love they are my adversaries: but I give myself unto prayer” (Psalms 109:4).

“Let my prayer be set forth before thee as incense; and the lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice” (Psalms 141:2).

“I will never accept honour from evil people, because I am always praying against their evil deeds” (Psalm 141:5b GNT).

“The sacrifice of the wicked is an abomination to the LORD: but the prayer of the upright is his delight” (Proverbs 15:8).

“The LORD is far from the wicked: but he heareth the prayer of the righteous” (Proverbs 15:29).

“It may be the LORD thy God will hear the words of Rabshakeh, whom the king of Assyria his master hath sent to reproach the living God, and will reprove the words which the LORD thy God hath heard: wherefore lift up thy prayer for the remnant that is left” (Isaiah 37:4).

“Go, and say to Hezekiah, thus saith the LORD, the God of David thy father, I have heard thy prayer, I have seen thy tears: behold, I will add unto thy days fifteen years” (Isaiah 38:5)

“And I set my face unto the Lord God, to seek by prayer and supplications, with fasting, and sackcloth, and ashes” (Daniel 9:3).

“Yea, whiles I was speaking in prayer, even the man Gabriel, whom I had seen in the vision at the beginning, being caused to fly swiftly, touched me about the time of the evening oblation” (Daniel 9:21).

“When my soul fainted within me I remembered the LORD: and my prayer came in unto thee, into thine holy temple” (Jonah 2:7).

“And when he was come into the house, his disciples asked him privately, why could not we cast him out? And he said unto them, this kind can come forth by nothing, but by prayer and fasting” (Mark 9:28, 29).

“And all things, whatsoever ye shall ask in prayer, believing, ye shall receive” (Matthew 21:22).

“But the angel said unto him, fear not, Zacharias: for thy prayer is heard; and thy wife Elisabeth shall bear thee a son, and thou shalt call his name John” (Luke 1:13).

“And it came to pass in those days, that he went out into a mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God” (Luke 6:12).

“And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint” (Luke 18:1).

“Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man” (Luke 21:36).

“And when he rose up from prayer, and was come to his disciples, he found them sleeping for sorrow. And said unto them, why sleep ye? Rise and pray, lest ye enter into temptation” (Luke 22:45, 46).

“These all continued with one accord in prayer and supplication, with the women, and Mary the mother of Jesus [Yahshua] and with his brethren” (Acts 1:14).

“Now Peter and John went up together into the temple at the hour of prayer, being the ninth hour” (Acts 3:1).

“But we will give ourselves continually to prayer, and to the ministry of the word” (Acts 6:4).

“A devout man, and one that feared God with all his house, which gave much alms to the people, and prayed to God always. He saw in a vision evidently about the ninth hour of the day an angel of God coming in to him, and saying unto him, Cornelius, thy prayers and thine alms are come up for a memorial before God” Acts 10:2-4)

“Peter therefore was kept in prison: but prayer was made without ceasing of the church unto God for him” (Acts 12:5).

“And on the Sabbath, we went out of the city by a river side, where prayer was wont to be made; and we sat down, and spake unto the women which resorted thither” (Acts 16:13)

“For God is my witness, whom I serve with my spirit in the gospel of his Son, that without ceasing I make mention of you always in my prayers” (Romans 1:9).

“Rejoicing in hope; patient in tribulation; continuing instant in prayer” (Romans 12:12).

“Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit” (Ephesians 6:18a).

“Defraud ye not one the other, except it be with consent for a time, that ye may give yourselves to fasting and prayer; and come together again, that Satan tempt you not for your incontinency” (1 Corinthians 7:5).

“Be careful for nothing; but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God” (Philippians 4:6).

“Continue in prayer, and watch in the same with thanksgiving” (Colossians 4:2).

“For it is sanctified by the word of God and prayer” (1 Timothy 4:5).

“I thank God, whom I serve from my forefathers with pure conscience, that without ceasing I have remembrance of thee in my prayers night and day” (2 Timothy 1:3).

“And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he has committed sins, they shall be forgiven him” (James 5:15).

“Confess your faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much” (James 5:16).

“But the end of all things is at hand: be ye therefore sober, and watch unto prayer” (1 Peter 4:7).

“Pray without ceasing” (1 Thessalonians 5:17).

Proven Way #5: Surround Yourself With An Energy Shield.

The last proven way we will talk about is energetically surrounding yourself in a spiritual shield. Shielding is an easy, fast, and effective way to protect yourself if in an area where negative energy might be. It only takes a moment, and it is done by asking King Yahshua Ha Mashiach and his mighty angels to surround your body with a protective layer of light and energy.

Pray and ask Yahshua the author and finisher of your faith (Hebrews 12:2) to be present with you, and protect you from any seen or unseen forces. As an example, you can call on Archangel Michael to protect you in times of fear, anxiety, or danger. But, if you don't ask for help, following the law of free will, the spiritual realm or angels of Yahveh are limited to what they can do. And yes, there is such a thing as divine intervention, but asking for help is much more efficient and secure.

Pray this prayer to surround yourself with the spiritual shield:

Ava Yahveh, my creator, and redeemer let your light surround me. I pray and ask for your spiritual shield and protection. Hide me under your wings. Please, be my refuge, fortress, and strength. Father Yahveh, I ask that you hold me close and be with me every step of the way. Fill me with your light and make me a clear and perfect channel. Let your light be my guide. Invoke your light within me, in Yahshua Ha Mashiach's name, Amein.

After you have prayed the above prayer, the next step is to meditate. You can visualize, feel, or even think of yourself surrounded by a cocoon of light. You will need to re-shield yourself from time to time by repeating the process because shields wear off.

CHAPTER 8

Defeating Temptation and Living A Demon-Free Life

One of the ways your spiritual shield could break for Satan and demons to attack and manipulate you is through temptation.

The moment you fall into temptation, your spiritual protection breaks, and demons are given the chance to torment your life.

When demons find out that they cannot break through your spiritual shield, they set you to temptation because they know that when you fall into their temptation, your spiritual shield will be broken for them to manipulate you.

Knowing how to defeat temptation is the secret key to keep you going in the right direction. The Bible says, *“Blessed is the man who endures temptation; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him” (James 1:12).*

Here are some of the benefits of defeating temptation:

- Your reputation will not be at stake.
- Your name is kept in the book of life for your salvation.
- Your faith is strengthened.
- Shows your commitment to Ava Yahveh to keep the covenants you have made.

These are some of the forms of temptation to avoid:

- Negative speech
- Pride
- Fornication
- Adultery
- Shining objects
- Anger
- Improper dressing
- Bad Habits

In this chapter, we will talk about five ways to overcoming temptation.

You may sometimes feel that a temptation is too overpowering for you to bear, but that's a lie from Satan.

Yahveh has promised never to allow more on you than he puts within you to handle it.

Yahveh will not permit any temptation that you could not overcome. The Bible says, ***“Let no one say when he is tempted, I am tempted by God”; for God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone. But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by his own desires and enticed. Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death” (James 1:13-15).***

There's always a way out. The Bible says, ***“No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it” (1 Corinthians 10:13).***

5 Ways to Overcoming Temptation

Practice the following 5 biblical keys to defeat temptation:

1. Refocus Your Attention On Something Else

It may surprise you that the Bible does not tell us to “resist temptation.” Rather the Bible tells us to “resist the devil” James 4:7 says, *“Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.”*

Instead, we are advised to refocus our attention because resisting a thought doesn't work. It only intensifies our focus on the wrong thing and strengthens its allure (attractions).

Every time you try to block a thought out of your mind, you drive it deeper into your memory.

By resisting it, you are actually reinforcing it.

You don't defeat temptation by fighting the feeling of it. The more you fight a feeling, the more it consumes and controls you.

You strengthen it every time you think it.

Since temptation always begins with a thought, the quickest way to neutralize its allure (attraction) is to turn your attention to something else.

Don't fight the thought just change the channel of your mind and get interested in another idea. The Bible says, ***"Flee also youthful lusts; but pursue righteousness, faith, love, peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart"*** (2 Timothy 2:22).

The battle for sin is won or lost in your mind. Whatever gets your attention will get you. Job said, ***"I have made a covenant with my eyes; why then should I look upon a young woman?"*** (Job 31:1) The Psalmist said, ***"Turn away my eyes from looking at worthless things"*** (Psalm 119:37a).

That's why repeating "I must stop eating too much... or stop smoking ... or stop lusting" is a self-defeating strategy.

It keeps you focused on what you don't want. It's like announcing, "I'm never going to do what my dad did." You are setting yourself up to repeat it.

The more you focus on "I don't want to do this," the stronger it draws you into its web.

Ignoring a temptation is far more effective than fighting it. Once your mind is on something else, the temptation loses its power.

So when temptation calls you on the phone, don't argue with it, just hand up!

Sometimes this means physically leaving a temptation situation. At times it's okay to run away. The Bible says, ***"Flee sexual immorality. Every sin that a man does is outside the body, but he who commits sexual immorality sins against his own body"*** (1 Corinthians 6:18).

Get up and turn off the television set. Walk away from a group that is gossiping. Leave the theater in the middle of the movie. The Bible says, ***"Blessed is the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly. Nor stands in the path of sinners, nor sits in the seat of the scornful; but his delight is in the law of the Lord, and in His law he meditates day and night"*** (Psalm 1:1-2).

Do whatever is necessary to turn your attention to something else.

Spiritually, your mind is your most vulnerable (weak) organ.

To reduce temptation, keep your mind occupied with Yahveh's Word and other good thoughts.

You can defeat bad thoughts by thinking of something better. The Bible says, ***"Be careful how you think; your life is shaped by your thoughts"*** (Proverbs 4:23, GNT).

This is the principle of replacement. You overcome evil with good. The Bible says, ***"Do not let evil defeat you; instead, conquer evil with good."*** (Romans 12:21).

Satan can't get your attention when your mind is preoccupied with something else. The Bible says, ***"Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things are noble, whatever things are just, whatever things are pure, whatever things are lovely, whatever things are of good report, if there is any virtue and if there is anything praiseworthy—meditate on these things"*** (Philippians 4:8, see also Hebrews 3:1 and 2 Timothy 2:8).

If you are serious about defeating temptation you must manage your mind and monitor your media intake.

Don't allow trash into your mind indiscriminately. Be selective. Choose carefully what you think about (read 1 Corinthians 10:5).

This takes a lifetime of practice, but with the help of the Holy Spirit you can reprogram the way you think.

2. Reveal Your Struggle to Godly Friend or Support Group

You don't have to broadcast it to the whole world, but you need at least one person you can honestly share your struggles with. The Bible says, ***“Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their labor. For if they fall, one will lift up his companion. But woe to him who is alone when he falls, For he has no one to help him up” (Ecclesiastes 4:9-10).***

If you are losing the battle against a persistent bad habit, an addiction, or a temptation, and you are stuck in a repeating cycle of god intention-failure-guilt, you will not get better on your won!

You need the help of other people.

Some temptations are only overcome with the help of a partner, Pastor, Prophet, or a true man of Yahveh, who prays for you, directs you, encourages you, and holds you accountable.

Authentic, honest fellowship is the antidote to your lonely struggle against those sins that won't budge. The Bible says, ***“Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The earnest prayer of a righteous person has great power and produces wonderful results” (James 5:16, NLT).***

Do you want to be healed of that persistent temptation that keeps defeating you over and over?

Yahveh's solution is plain: Don't repress it; confess it! Don't conceal it; reveal it.

Revealing your feeling is the beginning of healing. Hiding your hurt only intensifies it.

Problems grow in the dark and become bigger and bigger, but when exposed to the light of truth, they shrink.

You are only as sick as your secrets. So take off your mask, stop pretending you're perfect and walk into freedom.

At my assembly Mount Olivet Messianic Judaism we have seen the awesome power of this principle to break the grip of seemingly hopeless addictions and persistent temptations through a program we developed called Life Transformation.

It is a biblical eight-step recovery process based on the beatitudes of Yahshua and built around small support groups.

Many lives have been set free from all kinds of habits, hurts, and addictions through this program.

The Bible says, “***No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God is faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear it***” (1 Corinthians 10:13) and “all of us have sinned (Romans 3:23).

The reason we hide our faults is pride. We want others to think we have everything “under control.”

The truth is, whatever you can’t talk about is already out of control in your life: problems with your finances, kids, marriage, thoughts, sexuality, secret habits, or anything else.

If you could handle it on your own, you would have already done so. But you can’t. Will-power and personal resolutions aren’t enough.

Some problems are too ingrained, too habitual, and too big to solve on your own. You need a support group or an accountability partner, prophet, or pastor who will encourage you, support you, pray for you, direct you, love you unconditionally, and hold you accountable.

Let me ask you a tough question: What are you pretending isn’t a problem in your life?

What are you afraid to talk about?

You’re not going to solve it on your own.

Yes, it is humbling to admit our weaknesses to others, but a lack of humility is the very thing that is keeping you from getting better. ***The Bible says, “God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble” (James 4:6).***

3. Resist the Devil

After we have humbled ourselves and submitted to Yahveh, we are then told to resist the Devil. The Bible says, “***Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you***” (James 4:7)

The New Testament often describes the believer’s life as a spiritual battle against evil forces, using war terms such as fight, conquer, strive, and overcome.

Believers are often compared to soldiers serving in enemy territory. How can we resist? The Apostle Paul tells us, ***“Take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God” (Ephesians 6:17).***

The first step is to accept Yahveh’s salvation. You won’t be able to say no to the Devil unless you’ve said yes to Yahshua Ha Mashiach.

Without Yahshua the Messiah we are defenseless against the Devil, but with “the helmet of salvation, our minds are protected by Yahveh. The Bible says, ***“To the law and to the testimony! If they do not speak according to this word, it is because there is no light in them” (Isaiah 8:20).*** Again the Bible says, ***“Here is the patience of the saints; here are those who keep the commandments of God and the faith of Jesus [Yahshua]” (Revelation 14:12).***

Remember this: If you’re a believer, Satan cannot force you to do anything. He can only suggest. Second, you must use the Word of Yahveh as your weapon against Satan (Ephesians 6:17).

Yahshua Ha Mashiach modeled this when he was tempted in the wilderness (Matthew 4).

Every time Satan suggested a temptation, Yahshua countered it by quoting Scripture. He didn’t argue with Satan. He simply quoted scripture from memory. We must do the same.

There is power in Yahveh’s Word, and Satan fears it. That’s why memorizing scripture is absolutely essential to defeating temptation.

If you don’t have any bible verses memorized, you’ve got no bullets in your gun!

Today, I challenge you to memorize one verse a week for the rest of your life. Imagine how much stronger you’ll be.

Third, commit yourself to prayer without ceasing (Matthew 26:41). Remember prayer moves the hand of Yahveh into your life.

4. Realize Your Vulnerability

Yahveh warns us never to get cocky (too confident) and overconfident; that is the recipe for disaster. The Bible says, ***“The heart is deceitful above all things. And it is extremely sick; who can understand it fully and know its secret motives?” (Jeremiah 17:9, AMP)***

We must never let down our guard and think we are beyond temptation. Don’t carelessly place yourself in tempting situations. Avoid them. The Bible says, ***“A wise man fears and departs from evil, but a fool rages and is self-confident” (Proverbs 14:16).***

Remember that it is easier to stay out of temptation than to get out of it. The Bible says, ***“Therefore let him who thinks he stands take heed lest he fall” (1 Corinthians 10:12).***

5. Request Yahveh’s Help

Heaven has a 24-hour emergency hotline.

Yahveh wants you to ask him for assistance in overcoming temptation. The Bible says, ***“Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify Me” (Psalm 50:15).***

The Bible guarantees that our cry for help will be heard because Yahshua the Messiah is sympathetic to our struggle. The Bible says, ***“For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin” (Hebrew 4:15)***

If Yahshua Ha Mashiach is waiting to help us defeat temptation, why don't we turn to him more often?

Honestly, sometimes we don't want to be helped! We want to give in to temptation even though we know it is wrong.

At that moment we think we know what's best for us more than Yahveh does.

At other times we are embarrassed to ask Yahveh for help because we keep giving in to the same temptation over and over.

But Yahveh never gets irritated, bored, or impatient when we keep coming back to him. The Bible says, ***“Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need” (Hebrews 4:16).***

Yahveh's love is everlasting and his patience endures forever. If you have to cry out for Yahveh's help two hundred times a day to defeat a particular temptation, he will still be eager to give mercy and grace, so come boldly.

Ask Yahveh for the power to do the right thing and then expect him to provide it.

Temptations keep us dependent upon Yahveh. Just as the roots grow stronger when the wind blows against a tree, so every time you stand up to a temptation you become more like Yahshua.

When you stumble –which you will – it is not fatal (accident).

Instead of giving in or giving up, look up to Yahveh, expect him to help you, and remember the reward that is waiting for you. The Bible says, ***“Happy is the man who doesn't give in and do wrong when he is tempted, for afterwards he will get as his reward the crown of life that God has promised those who love him” (James 1:12, TLB).***

In conclusion, overcoming temptations will help you live a demon-free life. Demons will never be able to harass or torment your life if you never fall into temptation. Your life will be free from the attacks and manipulations of demons. You will be a free person and your peace and happiness will know no boundaries.

The Holy Scripture warns us: ***“And in all things that I have said unto you be circumspect: and make no mention of the name of other gods, neither let it be heard out of thy mouth” (Exodus 23:13 see also Hosea 2:16, 17).*** Jeremiah also prophesized that our translators (or scribes) will make are bound to make mistakes or error: ***“How do ye say, we are wise, and the law of the LORD is with us? Lo, certainly in vain made he it; the pen of the scribes is in vain” (Jeremiah 8:8).*** For instance, “Amen” is an inappropriate word, because “Amen” is the name of an Egyptian god [— a primeval Egyptian personification of air and breath; worshipped especially at Thebes] which has been inserted into the Bible during its translation. “Amein” is the right word in the original Hebrew Bible which means “so be it” or “certainly”.

I have tried my best to correct some of these errors by providing the appropriate words or names in place of the wrong ones in this book. Take note of them and teach others also.

Beloved, my advice to you is to reject any unqualified information drawn from sources outside the Bible, such as the current ideas, traditions, and cultures of the world.


Do not rely on the teachings of men rather on the teachings of the Holy Spirit.


